#### 2023: who's in?

cs3community.org

- This is first in person event after pandemic
  - 120 on-site participants
  - 30+ remote participants (number still growing)
  - Average in last 3 pre-pandemic events (2018-2020)
    - 130 participants
- Large institutional diversity:
  - Universities, International Organisations, NRENs, Computing Centres, Private Companies: SMEs and Enterprises, European Commission
- Large geographical diversity:
   Europe and beyond => Brazil, China, United States, ...



#### Evolution of focus areas



- 2014: Beginning... isolated cloud storage services deployments
- 2015: Getting the basics right: hardening operations and technology
- 2016: New applications: document handling, productivity, ...
- 2017: Infrastructure fabric: home directories, Windows/Mac/Linux
- 2018: Live research workspace: store and share data and research objects
- 2019: Integration into research environments: Jupyter Notebooks, Open Data, ...
- 2020: Federations & Interoperability: OCM, ScienceMesh, HIFIS,...
- 2021/22: Future Storage & Collaboration: Open Science, Research Clouds, EOSC...
- 2023: Back together: consolidation of efforts and lookout for future opportunities
