


During the course of the project, max 85% of the grant can be received from the EC (according to the spending profile of the Consortium), the remaining 15% is only released after the final report (10% final payment + 5 % guarantee fund)

Periodic reporting (financial part) to the EC at M18, M36, M48

Financial Statements: special forms on the Participant Portal where beneficiaries will report and claim to the EC their eligible costs.



- → Each beneficiary will need to complete on the Participant Portal its Financial Statement.
- → The PDFs of the Financial Statements will be generated automatically by the system
- → To be submitted 2 weeks before the deadline (60 days after the end of period)
- → Communication of deadlines beforehand

Periodicity: at M18, M36, M48

CFS – Certificate on Financial Statement

- The CFS is a factual report produced by an independent auditor. Its
 purpose is to enable the European Commission or grant awarding
 agency to check whether costs declared in the financial statements
 are eligible.
- A separate CFS must be submitted for each beneficiary (and affiliated entity) that requests total of €430 000 or more as reimbursement of total requested contribution calculated according to its usual cost accounting practices.
- CFS must be submitted with the final report. (based on the planned budget only two beneficiaries are concerned: CERN, GSI)
- Cost of CFS is eligible cost.
