


Project Office's Role

- Coordinate the execution of all WPs.




Deliverable Workflow









Milestone Workflow

Information on EU funding, Acknowledgement

Each beneficiary must ensure open access (free of charge, online access for any user) **to all peer-reviewed scientific publications** relating to its results.

In particular, it must as soon as possible and at the latest on publication, deposit a machinereadable electronic copy of the **published version or final peer-reviewed manuscript** accepted for publication in a repository for scientific publications.

All **HEARTS publications**, as well as communication and dissemination content (i.e. presentations, posters, flyers, videos, etc.) must include the following acknowledgement:








Indico:

Indico categories for HEARTS:


- https://indico.cern.ch/category/16112/ is the root HEARTS category.

EDMS:


For any document that is created by the project team, and has to go through a review and approval process, EDMS is the document management system in use.





CERNbox:


- The access will be granted through a link and password.

Mattermost:


CERN main communication channel for individual or group chat.
