






Footprint Map (Entrances and Accessibility Information)

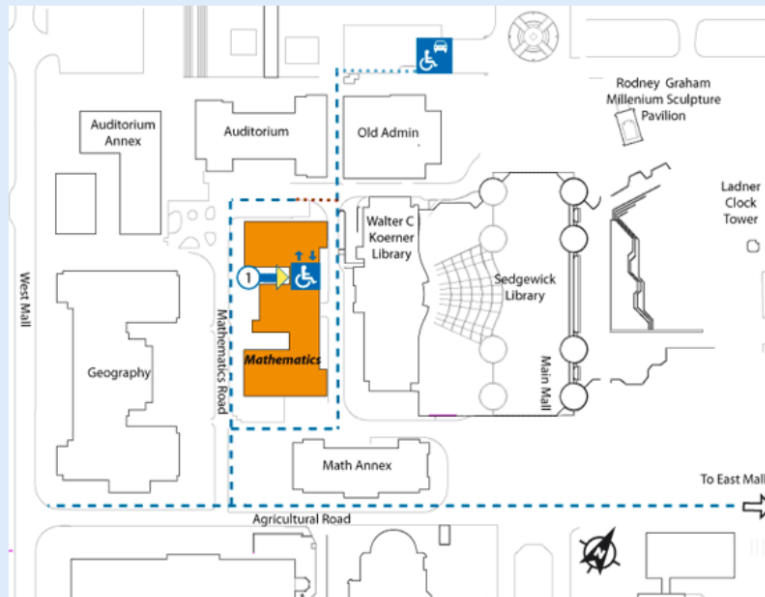



