Hamburg

A vibrant harbour city in the North Germany

- There's always something going on, especially at the <u>beginning</u>
 of <u>summer</u> when the weather is usually great (well, it's <u>ok</u>)
- World class art galleries, such as <u>Kunsthalle</u> and <u>Deichtorhallen</u>
- Classical music: Elbphilharmonie and Laeiszhalle
- Not so classical music: Venues throughout the city, such as <u>Molotow</u>, <u>Grosse Freiheit 36, Docks et al.</u>, <u>Mojo</u>, <u>U&G</u>, ...
- Very lively <u>club scene</u> and <u>nightlife</u> on the Reeperbahn
- World famous attractions like <u>Miniature Wonderland</u>
- Many <u>musicals/shows</u> (mostly in german)
- Alster lakes, Elbe tunnel, Harbour tours (insider tip: HVV 62)
- Speaking of which <u>Hafengeburtstag</u> is weekend of 10-12 May..
- Where I've lived for more than 23 years.. and where ATLAS held a successful S&C Week in the summer of 2018

There will be lots of visitors to Hamburg the weekend before the workshop










- This year Hamburg Harbour is 835 years old
 - Usually around a million visitors over the weekend
 - Worth a <u>visit</u> hotels are busy

Arrival

Easy to reach from the airport

- To Hamburg:
 - Most flights from within Europe between one and two hours, some budget airlines as well as national carrier. Usually no more than 200-250€ if booked early enough
 - Connections from further afield via the usual European hubs
 - Good connectivity via train, within Germany and from neighbouring countries
- To DESY:
 - Journey from the airport via S-Bahn (S1) and bus (No.1), about an hour: 3,60€
 - There are some roadworks/diversions
 near DESY, will provide more info nearer the time
 - A taxi costs 50-60€



DESY Hamburg

Laboratory

- Once the home of the <u>HERA</u> e^{*}p collider,
 Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron, <u>DESY</u>, is <u>located</u> to the west of the city, in Bahrenfeld
- The lab hosts two of the largest <u>ATLAS</u> and <u>CMS</u> groups, a <u>Belle 2</u> group, and many smaller on site Particle Physics experiments including <u>ALPS</u>, as well as significant <u>computing resources</u> (including T2s) and long established expertise e.g in <u>dCache</u>
- There is also an increasingly large <u>photon science</u>
 presence on site: <u>PETRA III/IV</u>, <u>XFEL</u>, <u>CFEL</u> as well
 as plasma wakefield research <u>FLASH(Forward)</u>



DESY Hamburg

On site facilities

- Planning for Monday lunchtime until Friday lunchtime
 - We have the large auditorium for the full week*
 - A second room for up to 80 people every day except Wednesday
 - Wednesday afternoon a smaller room (30 people) is reserved for board meetings
- *There is a weekly <u>Particle and AstroPhysics</u>
 <u>Colloquium</u> at DESY on Tuesday at 15:30, which could be include in the programme with a related topic and speaker, move to another day if needed
- Wifi Eduroam is available and is usually sufficient
- Lunch at 1pm in the on-site canteen, typically 5-8€
- Mid-session coffee and cake breaks will be included








Accomodation

DESY Hostel and many hotels in Hamburg

- The <u>DESY hostel</u> is an on-site and inexpensive option, 35€ per night for an en-suite single room (45€ double)
 - Currently more limited in availability, as we are still hosting many Ukrainian refugees
 - We have reserved 40 single rooms, which can be booked using the registration form here and the name "WLCGHSF2024"
 - Rooms are reserved from Friday May 9, but you're not obliged to stay the weekend before!
- There are many hotels in Hamburg, large price range
 - A hotel list will be made on the workshop indico
 - Those shown on the right are prices per night arriving Sunday May 11, leaving Friday May 16
 - We're trying to reserve some rooms at the <u>Mercure</u>



Social Activities

Reception and Dinner

- Reception at DESY on Monday evening
 - Welcome drinks and finger food
 - o Is there interest in holding a poster session?
- Planning the dinner on Wednesday evening at <u>Altes Mädchen</u>, at a local craft brewery, <u>Ratsherrn</u>, in the <u>Sternschanze</u> district
 - Very successful ATLAS dinner there in 2018, impressive and seemingly endless buffet
 - Plenty of room to move around and indoors and outdoors, with drinks included until 23h
 - During registration, should also be the option to sign up for a Brewery tour (in English) for a max. 2 x 25 people
- Transport there from DESY will be provided, make your own way back via public transport (S-Bahn is a few minutes away)

And some important dates

- WLCG/HSF Workshop at DESY Hamburg, May 13-17 2024: Anticipating an attendance of around 130 persons
