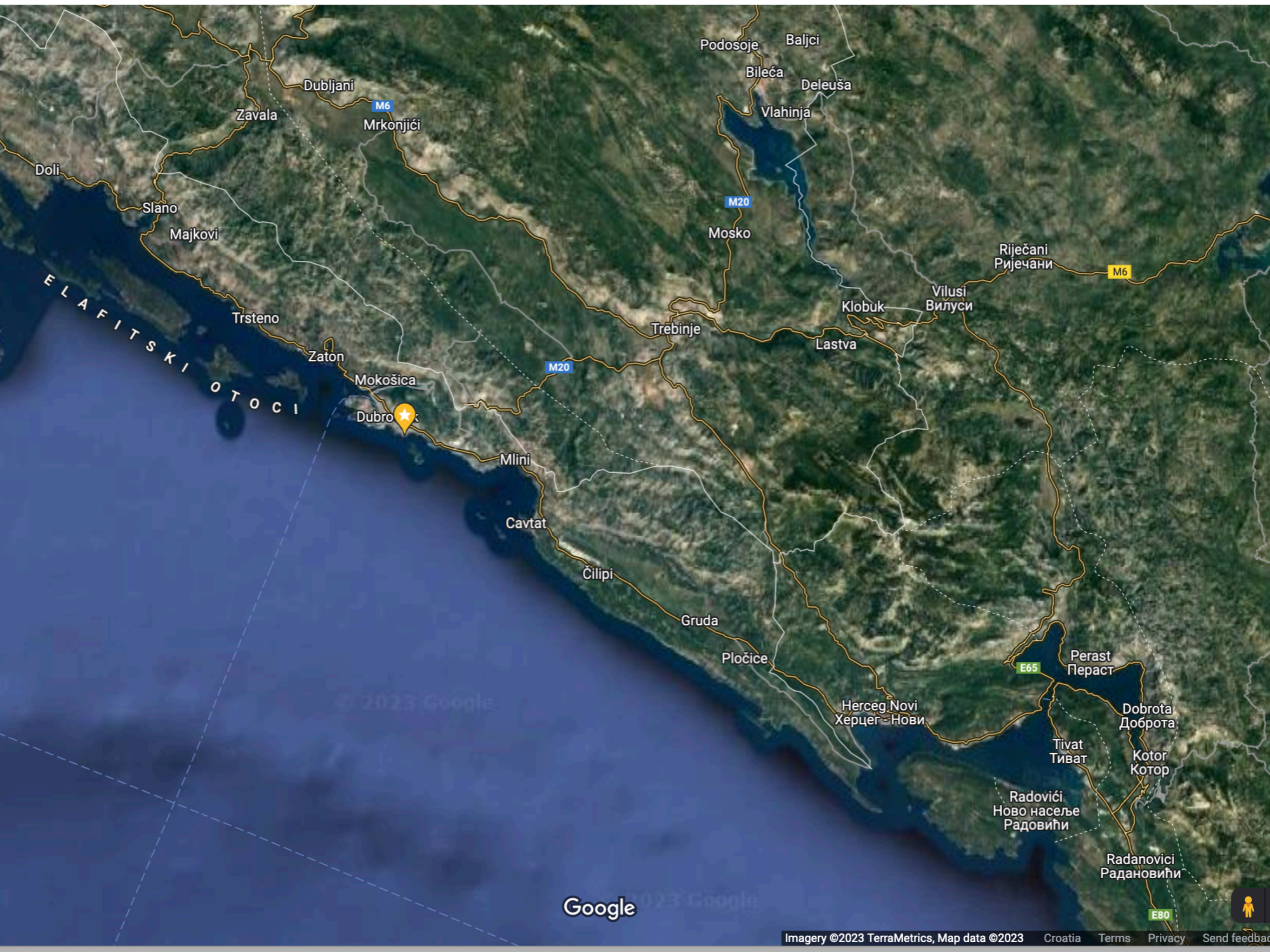

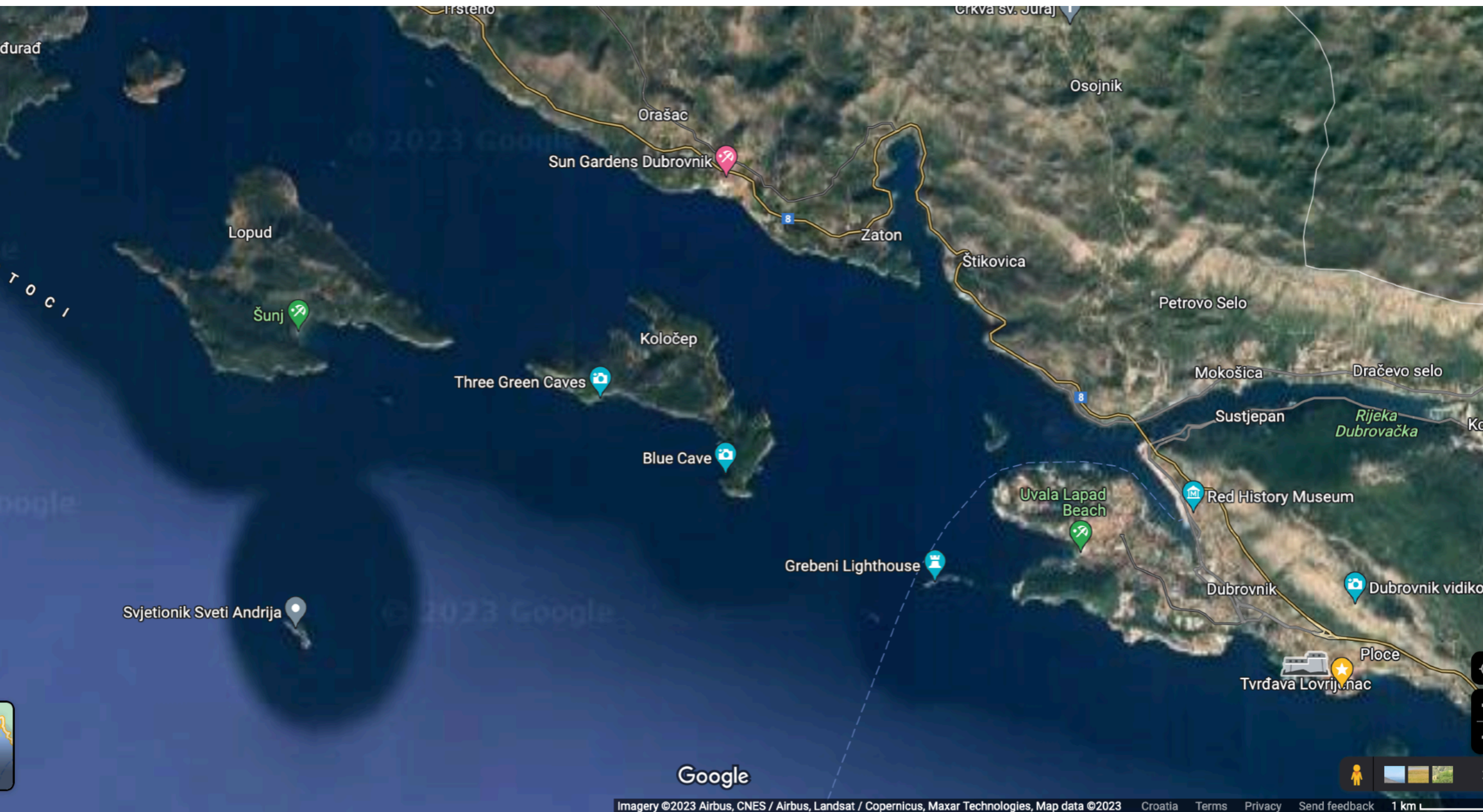

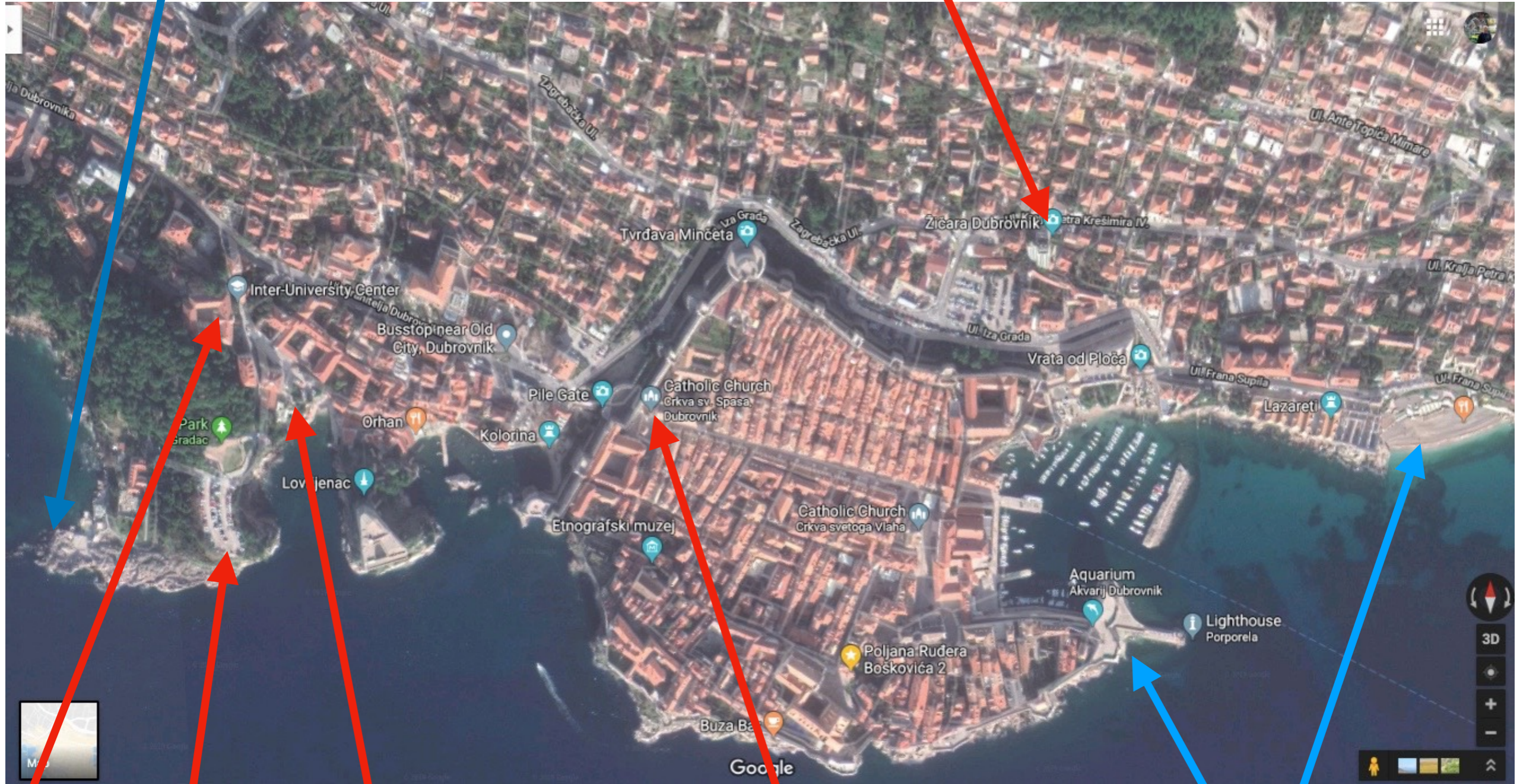

- Just get lost in the many small alleys...



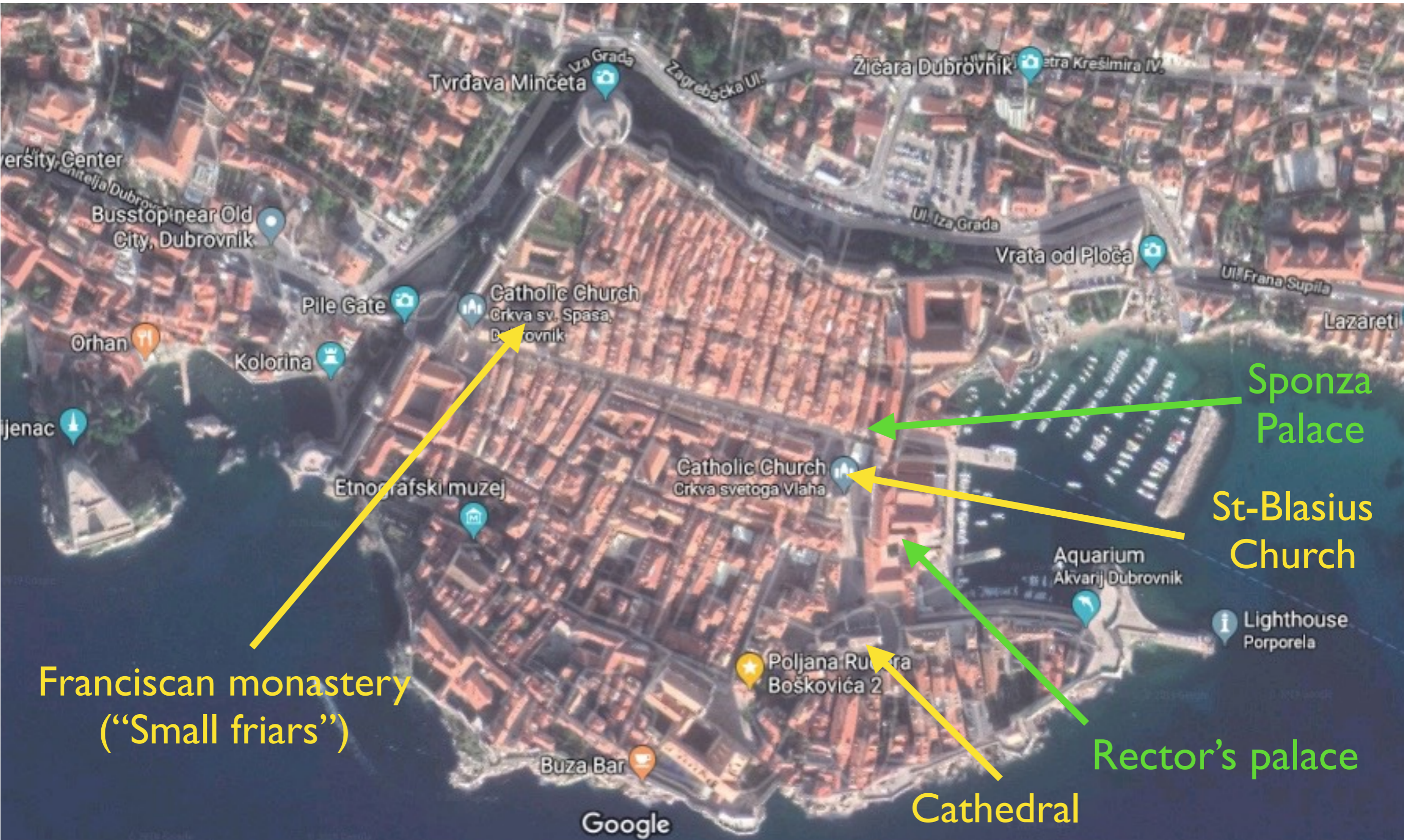
