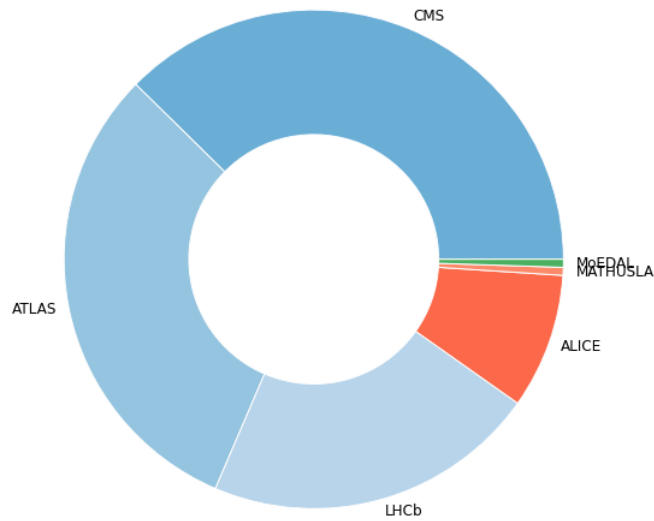
672 registrants

[was 62% last year]

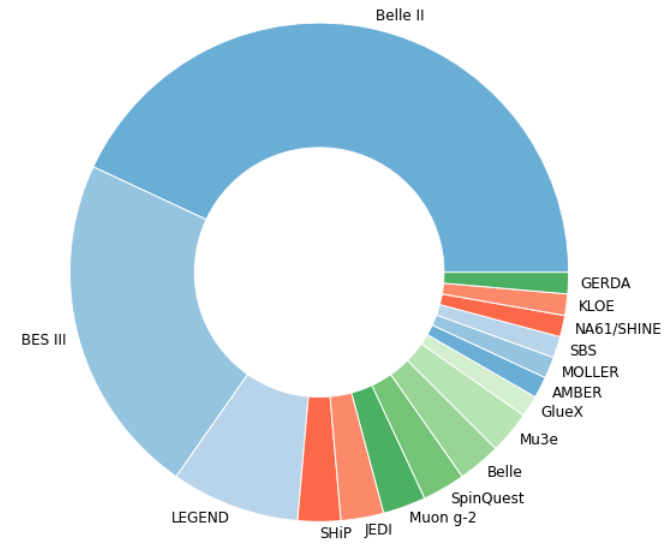

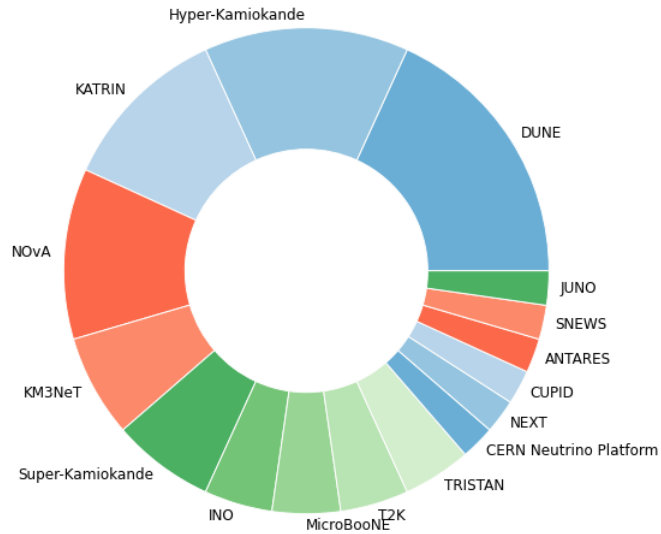

HEP (LHC) [194 registrants]



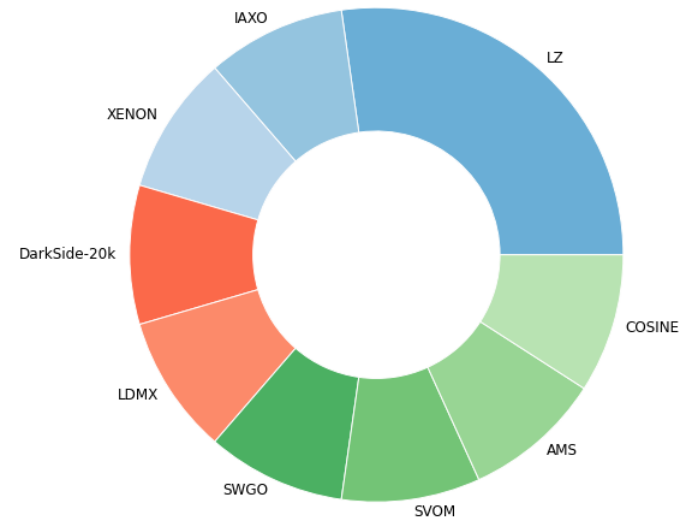

Neutrinos [44 registrants]

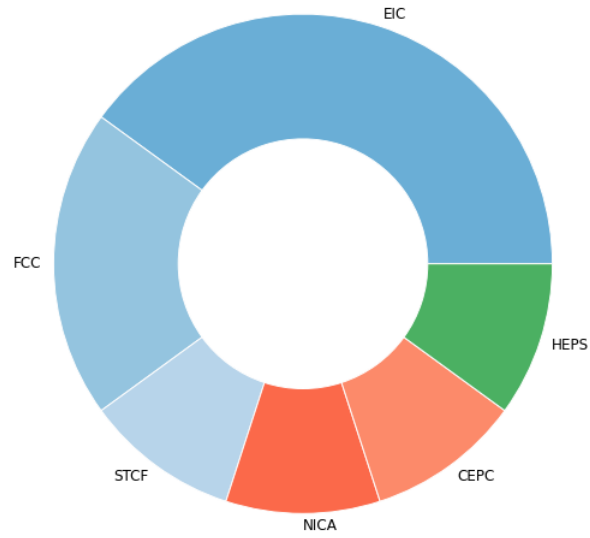

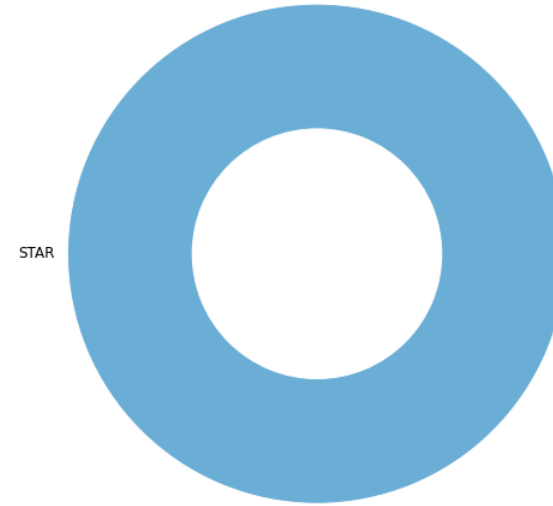

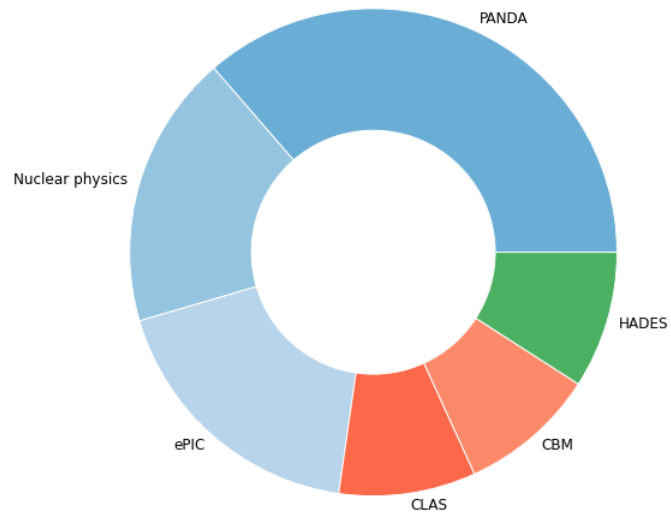

Accelerator / Particle source [10 registrants]



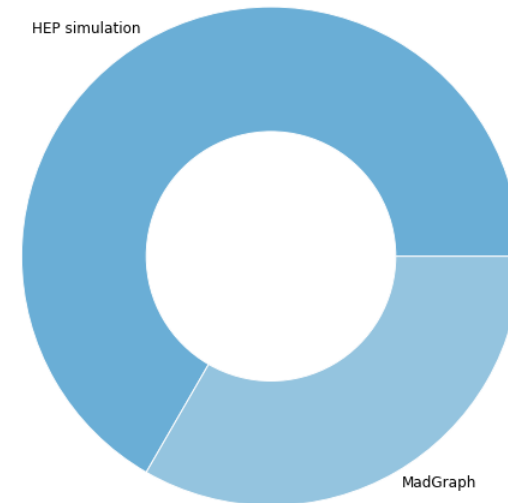

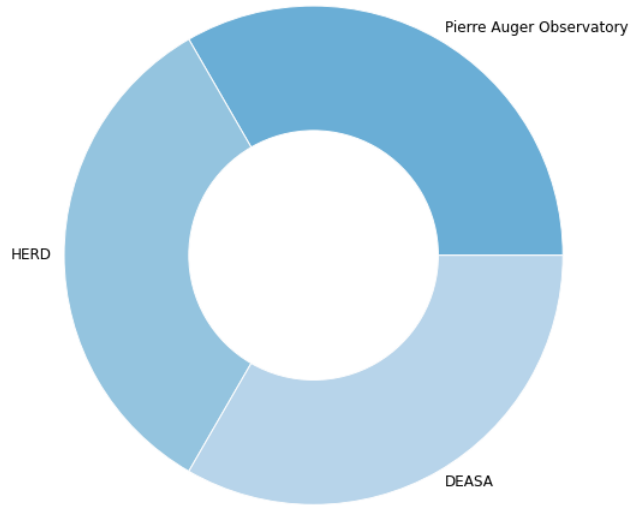

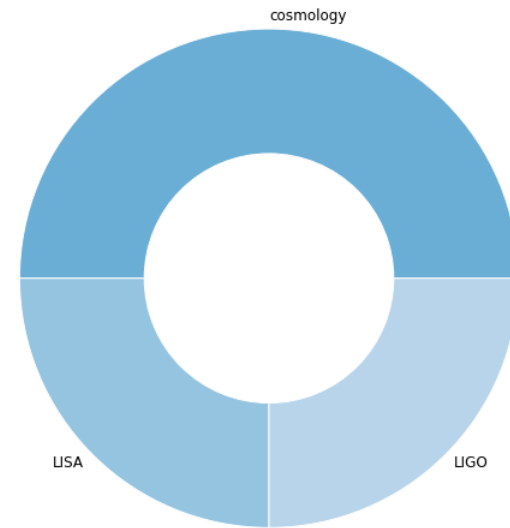

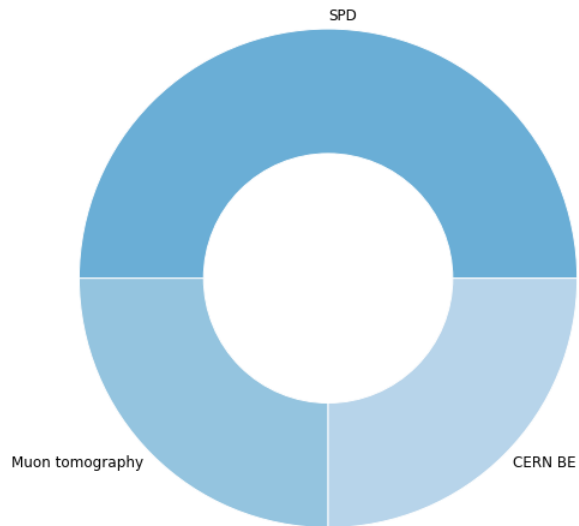

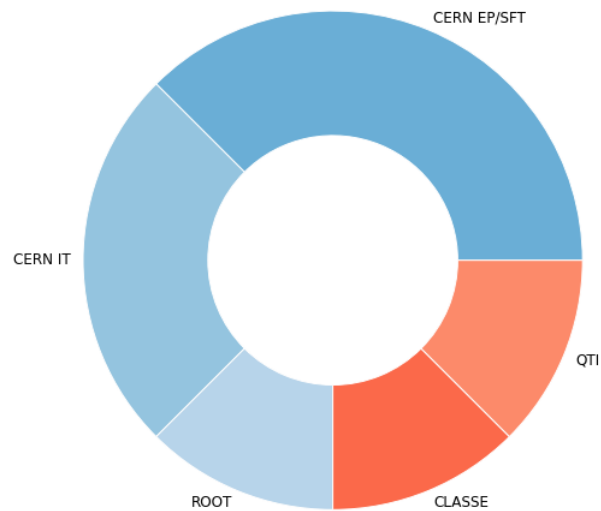

Cosmology [4 registrants]



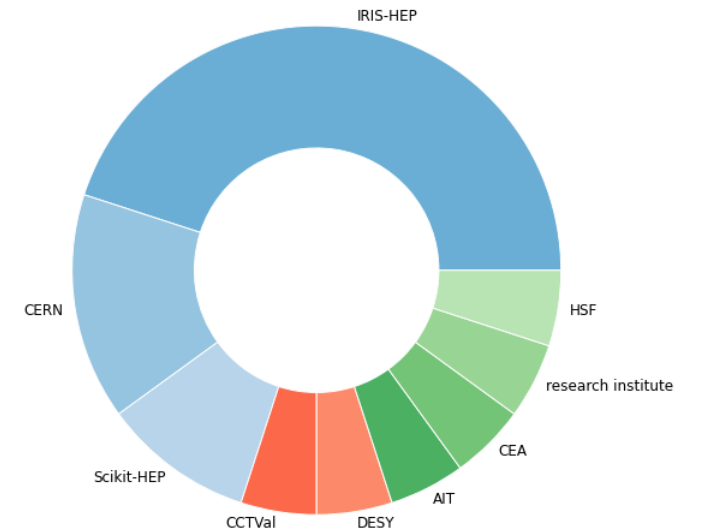

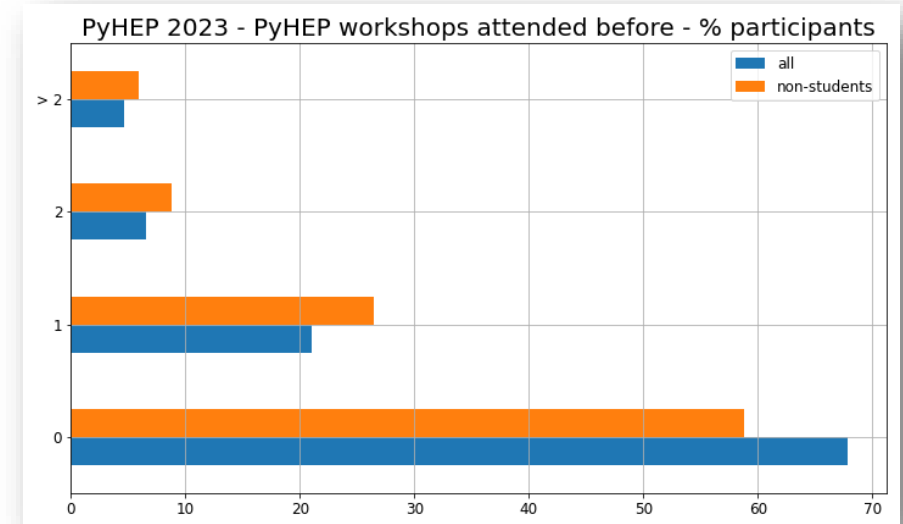
