

The second Collaboration Meeting of the Muon Collider Study will take place **from June 19 to June 22, 2023**. The meeting will be held **in person, in Orsay** (France), hosted by CEA.

We plan to cover at the meeting all areas of study and development, allowing ample time for both plenary and parallel sessions.

The main goals of the meeting will be to report on the progress of the study, in accordance with the defined work programme, and consolidate the share of tasks among all Collaborators, including the activities within the scope of the EU-funded MuCol Design Study. We especially wish to use this opportunity to address interfaces and integration among the various activities. The meeting is also an opportunity for the Collaboration Board to review activities, advances and plans.

The plenary and close-out session of the Collaboration Meeting will overlap with the Muon Collider Synergies Workshop (indico).

This meeting is also supported by MUST, the MUon collider Strategy network, a part of the I.FAST European project, whose specific objective is to review advances and promote collaboration on the muon source.
