### A nice cup of Tea:

The tea in your conference bag is a reminder of the Boston Tea Party of December 16, 1773, In which 342 chests of tea belonging to the British East India Company were thrown from ships into Boston Harbor by American patriots disguised as Mohawk Indians. The Americans were protesting both a tax on tea (taxation without representation) and the perceived monopoly of the East India Company. Please enjoy your tea and do not throw it into the Harbour.





#### Did you know:

Boston is named after a town in England, UK. When the Massachusetts Bay Company arrived in the city its most prominent members were from Boston, Lincolnshire, England, and so named the city after the one they had left.
