WHY DO WE DEAL WITH THE NURAGIC CIVILIZATION? AND WHY DO WE WANT IT TO BE RECOGNIZED IN THE UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE LIST?

- Uniqueness of the landscape and of the Nuragic civilization in the Western Mediterranean and beyond (over 12,000 sites spread across ALL 377 municipalities of Sardinia)
- Uniqueness within the history of Sardinia
- Identity value Sardinian cohesion element
- Universal value for WHL









To achieve these objectives, the Association has used the scientific advice of our university and research partners:

These collaborations have allowed us to study this ancient Sardinian civilization and its values; and to summarize them in the Dossiers for the candidacy for the UNESCO WHL.

The Dossiers document 32 sites representing the different phases and typologies of the approximately 12 thousand nuragic sites in total.








Thanks to these studies:

- In 2021 the Nuragic Civilization was included in the **Tentative List** of the Italian Ministry of Culture
- In 2023 our **Preliminary Assessment Dossier** was presented, and now is under discussion at the Ministry itself, awaiting sending to ICOMOS for the final evaluation









These documents and other studies, such as the **Guide Project** for the management of our sites, have confirmed and indeed strengthened our initial beliefs on the **extraordinary cultural quality** of the **monuments and landscapes** of the Nuragic civilisation.











6 La valle dei Nuraghi_Definizione di un sistema di coordinate



Next week an international research study on the economic impact of the "Isola dei Nuraghi" brand will be presented in Cagliari.































Our Association also carries out widespread activity to spread awareness of the Nuragic civilization in the local community network.
