

[1] Can we generate quiz questions using ChatGPT that can be imported into a Moodle question bank?



Why chose ChatGPT?

GPT: Generative Pre-trained Transformer

"By utilizing unsupervised learning to pre-train on vast amounts of text data, GPT can generate coherent and contextually relevant text ... based on learned patterns during training sessions"

very good at generating natural language


not a search engine





Web interface (via a browser)




API interface (using a script)



Hypothesized solution

Prompts => reusable, adaptable, tuned

Temperature => low (e.g. 0.2)

Interface => programatic

Methodology

- 1. <u>Decide</u> question import format
- 2. <u>Develop</u> ChatGPT prompts via its web interface
 - a) Use place holders to allow for easy reuse
 - b) <u>Define</u> roles and output format
 - c) <u>Provide</u> examples
- 3. Run prompts automatically via API interface

Question formats

Text

- + readable by humans
- requires manual input

GIFT

- + readable by humans
- difficult to set all settings

XML

- + can include all settings
- unreadable by humans






