


# CERN-related research in Norway

  - NorCC Centre for CERNrelated research



















- 6 institutes: UiO, UiB, HVL, USN, NTNU, UiA
- Largely funded by NFR through various grants
- Number of people is growing, now ~166 persons in Norway and ~25 staff and fellows at CERN
- Total 211 persons

- Summer students NorCC funds extra summer students
- **TTO-ILO** works for technology transfer to Norway and industrial return etc
- **CERN users** short and long term stays at CERN from our universities









 Norway will be evaluated by the Restricted European Committee for Future Accelerators (RECFA) 28th of April (Alex Read is our contact)

"Some of the <u>main aims of ECFA</u> are to contribute to the long-range planning of European high- energy physics facilities, to ensure a good balance between the roles of international and national laboratories and academic institutions, and to foster close relations between research and education in high-energy physics and other fields. ECFA also monitors the conditions for research and the sharing of facilities between physicists, irrespective of nationality and origin, ensuring that they are conducive to successful collaboration. The above aims are achieved through regular Plenary ECFA meetings and dedicated country visits by Restricted ECFA."
