

Report of the Inter-Union Commission for the History and Philosophy of Physics (IUPAP and IUHPST/DHST).

July 2022 to September 2023

In June 2022, the IUCHPP sponsored three early career historians of science to attend the 4<sup>th</sup> International Conference on the History of Physics organized in Dublin. This series of conferences try to set into dialogue professional historians of physics with physicists “with an interest in the history of physics”:
