Use of IUPAP affiliation in academic papers

IUPAP embraces and promotes the principle of open science and believes that sharing the results of scientific research is essential for the advancement of science and for its peaceful applications. Physicists, and scientists more generally including students, from any country around the world who feel excluded from the academic exchange through publishing in journals, based exclusively on their affiliation and/or country of origin, may formally apply to the IUPAP Executive Council to use the IUPAP as their affiliation. The papers shall have to be evaluated by the Executive Council before permission is given. Scientific contents must be totally unrelated to non-peaceful applications. IUPAP encourages authors to publish open access, but IUPAP is not in the position to cover the related publishing fees.
