



Future Committee Plans:

Rotation of committee members every two years, to have new people continuously in the committee, to bring new input and ideas.

- 1) Two members would be replaced (on voluntary basis) by new ones every two years.
- 2) One experienced member would be appointed as Deputy Chair of the committee.
- 3) The Chair would also rotate every two years and be replaced by an experienced committee member. The replaced Chair may remain as a committee member.
- 4)During the movements, one should try to consider diversity as far as region, gender, theory and experiment are concerned.

The award includes a monetary prize (which also helps with travel to the meeting), **a presentation at the DIS meeting**, and a published journal write-up of their research.
