- NuPECC holds regular meetings (this year so far in Ljubljana, Slovenia and Debrecen, Hungary) as country visits (next: Slovakia, Sweden, ... Switzerland no date fixed yet but coming in 2024 or 2025) and for regular business
 - At meetings usually several updates on nuclear physics in individual countries

- Presently most important activity: Community effort to assemble the Long Range Plan 2024, see website

- In view of the LRP2024, NuPECC is conducting a survey and headcount of experimental nuclear physics

 - CHIPP helping to collect CH headcount (gender specific numbers of: permanent staff, non-permanent/postdoc, PhD student)
 - Very preliminary total headcount numbers in CH exp. nucl. phys. (NuPECC is counting nuclear physicists, but e.g. not medical doctors in nuclear medicine):
 - [likely still incomplete] UBern (24), UGeneva (12), PSI (51), EPFL (90), ETHZ (30), UZurich (16)
 - Consider discussing your input with KK in person in order to get numbers straight, continues collecting until August
