ANTARES had been searching for cosmic neutrinos from the bottom of the Mediterranean Sea from 2006 until 2022, when KM3NeT, which since 2015 is being built in two sites in the same sea, overtook its sensitivity taking the baton. ANTARES is now preparing the final analyses with its complete data set while at the same time the first results with KM3NeT are coming out.
