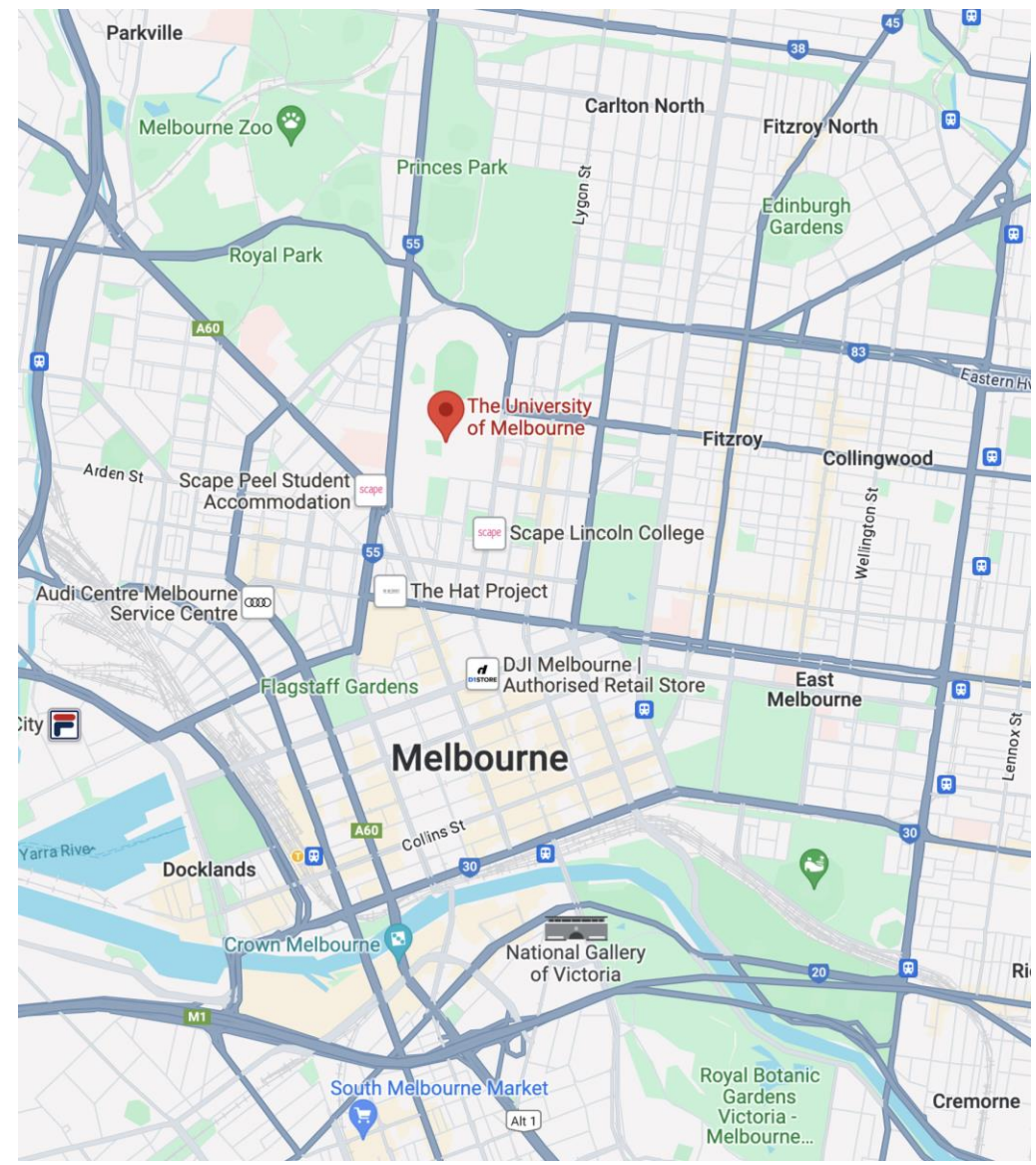
THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE

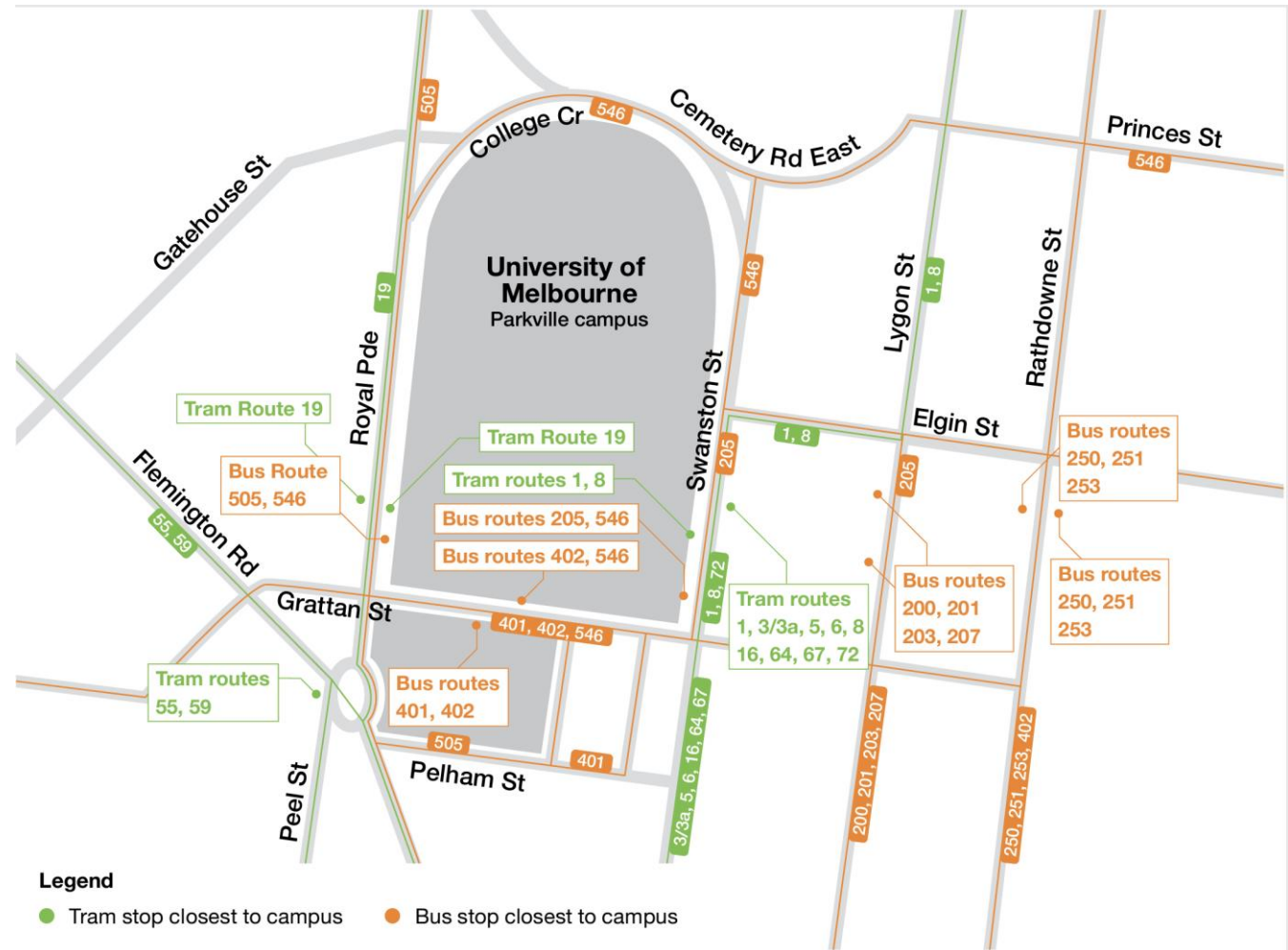


The university has several rooms with 400+ person capacity

HOW TO GET CONFERENCE VENUE

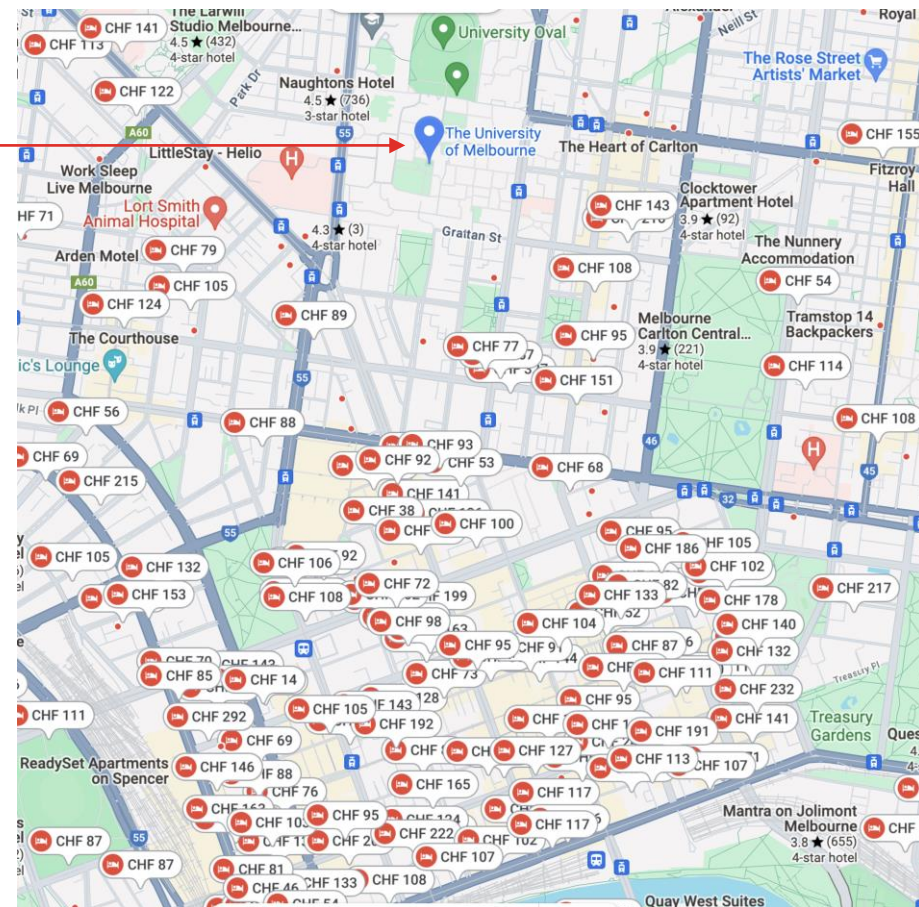
