For the first time ever, the CERN community has collaborated with established (non-science) writers to produce an anthology of fictional short stories. The stories, based on submissions of ideas from the world-wide CERN community, were put together in a book entitled *Collisions : Stories from the Science of CERN*, co-edited by Rob Appleby of Manchester University and Connie Potter of CERN. The book has sold thousands of copies and has been a huge success.
