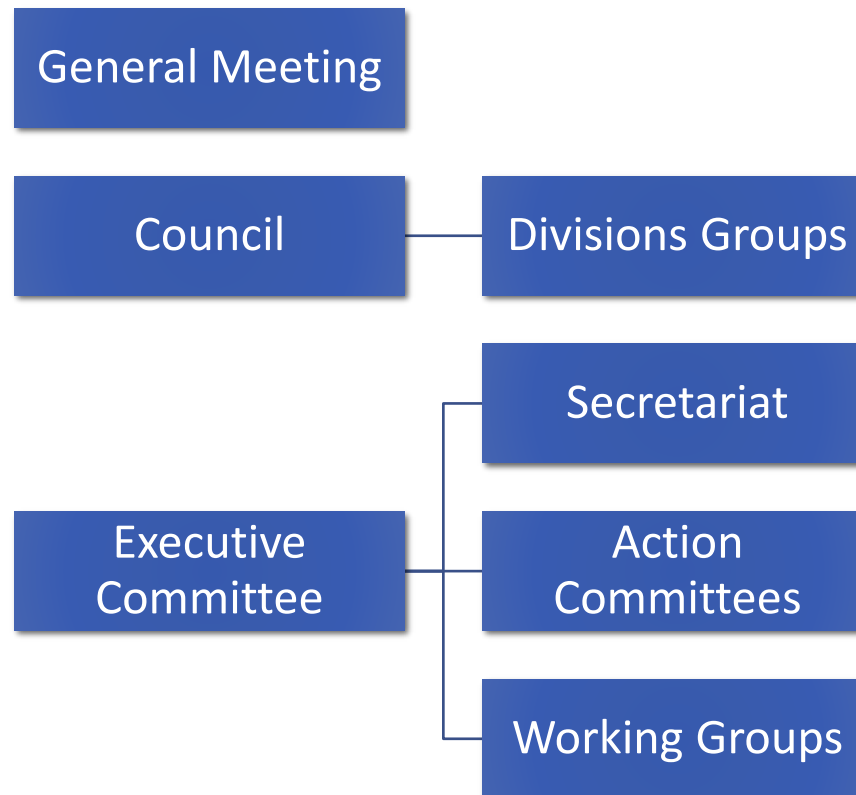

Powers and Duties of Council



- Adopt and Modify the Constitution and By-laws
- Adopt, Modify or Annul By-laws for Divisions and Groups
- Determine the annual Member contributions
- Establish or adopt Divisions and Groups.
- Accept reports of the Executive Committee
- Appoint the auditors
- Approve the annual accounts
- Elect members (including the President) to the Executive Committee
- Accept new Members
- Expel Members
- Elect EPS Fellows and Honorary Members
- Accept Collaborating Societies
- Accept gifts to the Society

Powers and Duties of the Executive Committee



- fulfil the object of the Society
- administer the assets and property of the Society
- summon the meetings of the Council and the General Meeting
- organise ballots and consultations as necessary
- appoint committees and working groups entrusted with special tasks within the general framework of the Society
- sponsor and supervise divisions and groups
- appoint delegates or representatives of the Society
- carry out decisions of the Council and of the General Meeting
- present to the Council or to the General Meeting as necessary annual and other reports and a financial report together with the auditor's report
- appoint the Secretary General and determine their remuneration
- negotiate terms and conditions with physics related societies for the purpose of conferring Collaborating Society status
- fulfil any other tasks which may be delegated to it by the General Meeting

Votes



Executive Committee

- Quorum is 50% of members
- Decisions taken by simple majority
- President has deciding vote in case of a tie

Council

- Quorum is 50% of members
- Votes are weighted
- Decisions taken by simple majority, except for MS fees and Constitutional changes
- President has deciding vote in case of a tie

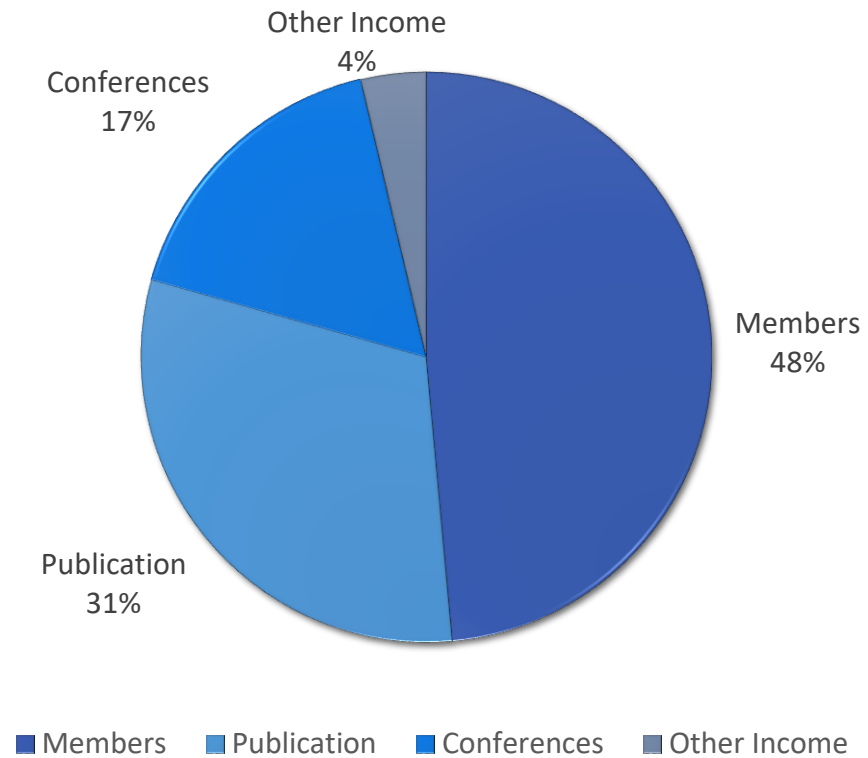

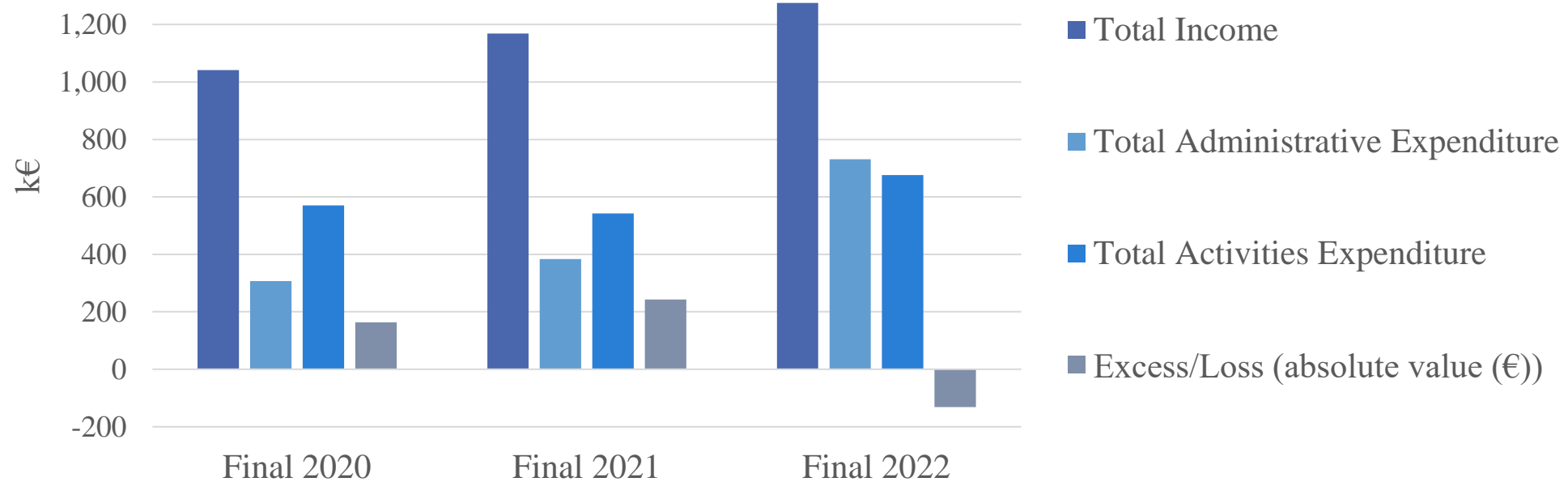

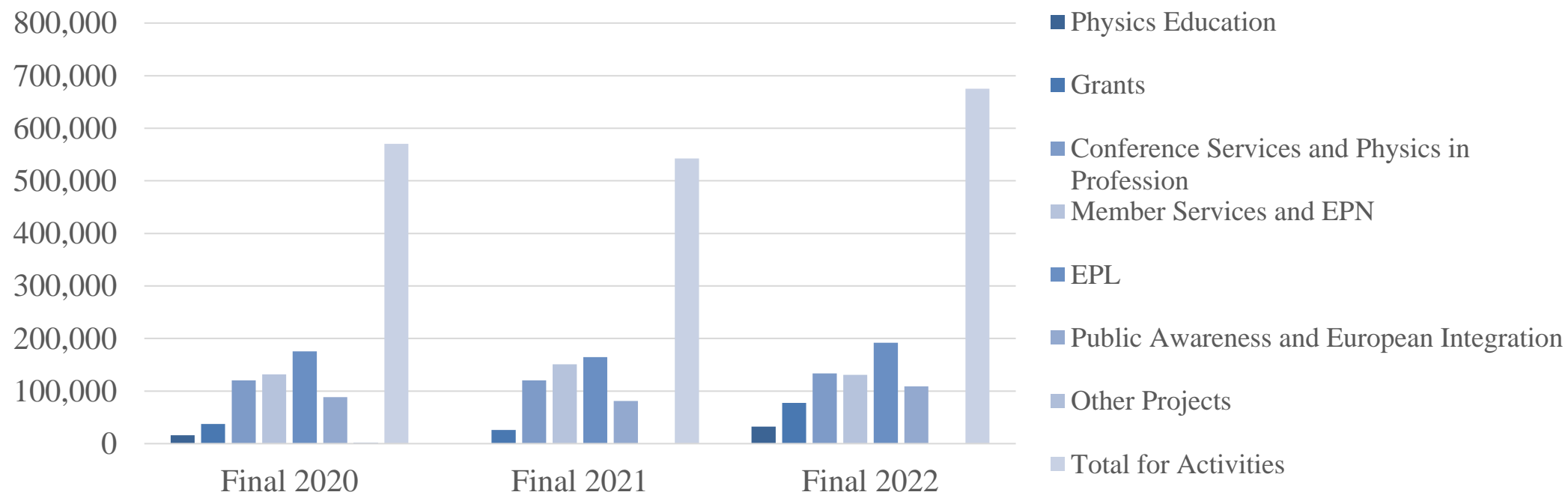


Excess/(Loss) 2020 - 2022
