The contribution of a wider outreach community will be recognized by a sentence.

The CB will be asked tomorrow to endorse the procedure and comment on 2 formats

IPPOG visibility : publications ? public notes ? articles ?

Conference proceedings organised by SPC [IMC; IPPOG description; RDB]

+ Several CERN Courier articles

+ Plenaries or talks given by chairs and forum members on specific views & projects

What about country specific papers ? Collaboration visibility ? Languages ? CDS ?

Mechanism in place : just like for conference proceedings or theory papers ...

A few names (ordered as you wish) + "on behalf of the IPPOG collaboration" (if relevant)
