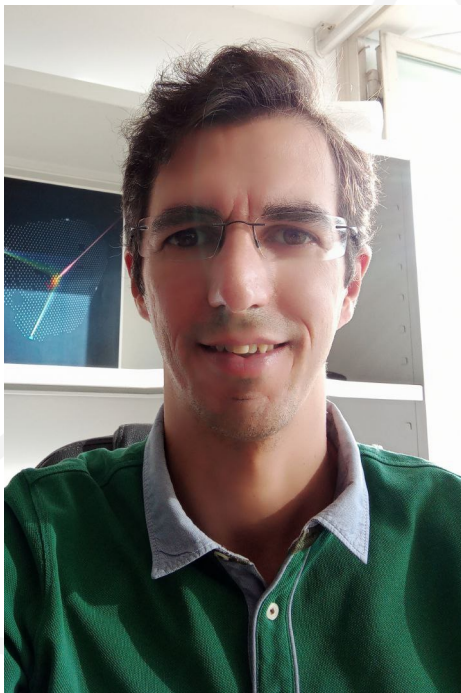

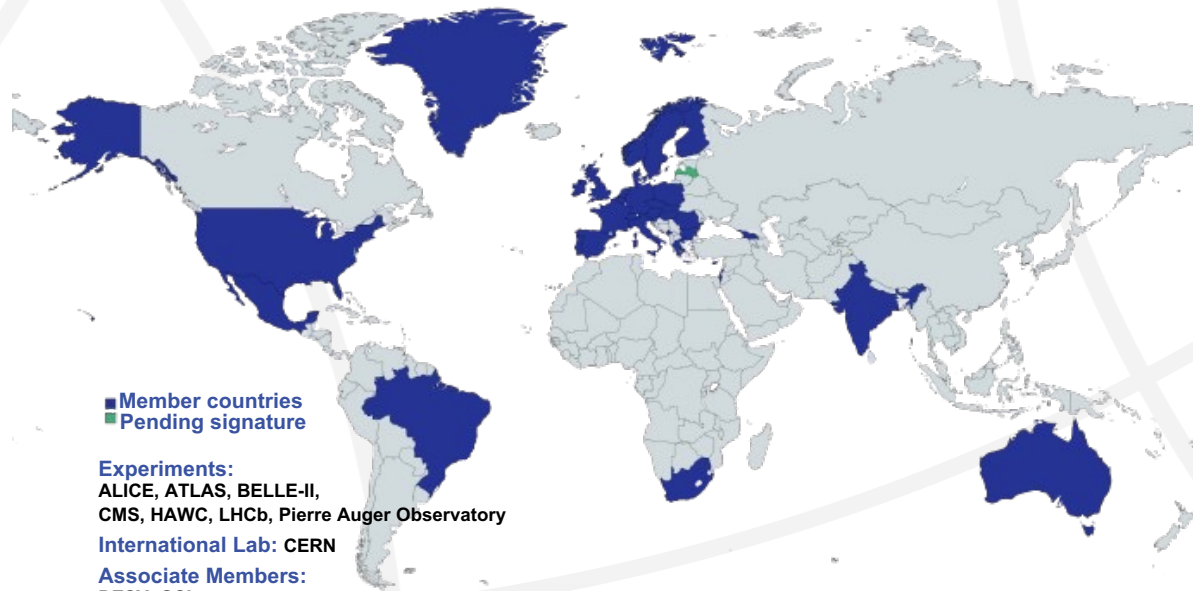

IPPOG World Map

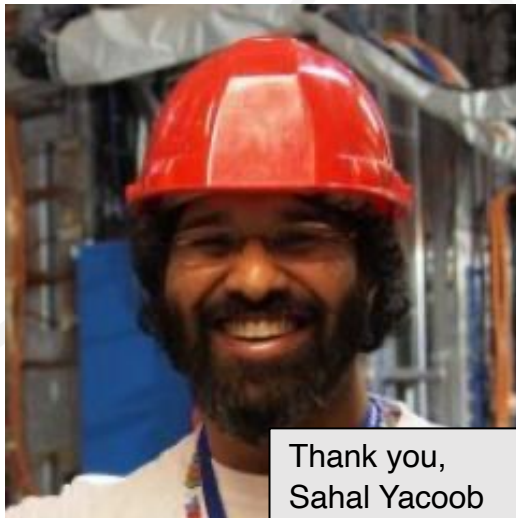

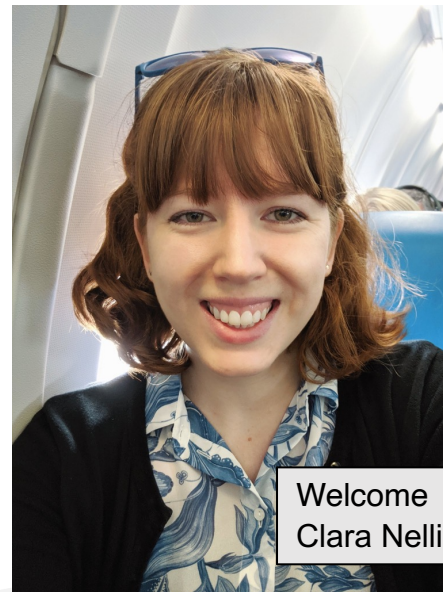

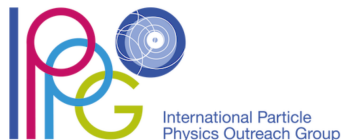
