

To reach KEK from Haneda Airport, there are three options: **taxi**, **express bus**, or **train**.


- 1. Taxi is the easiest way but costs more, and the arrival time depends on the traffic.
- 2. Express bus is less expensive and easy for travelers from abroad with luggage.
- 3. Train is more complicated but faster than taxi or bus, and arrival time is quite predictable.

No.	Transportation	Time Needed	Estimated Cost	Comment
1.	<u>Taxi</u>	3 hours	35,000 JPY/250 USD	Easy but expensive
2.	Express Bus	2.5 hours	2,300-5,500 JPY/16-40 USD	transfer twice
3.	Train	2.5 hours	3,000 JPY/22 USD	Several transfers


- Time: approx. 3 hours from Haneda APT to KEK.
- Fare: around 35,000 JPY/250 USD including highway fee.
- Payment: Some taxis accept major credit cards.

## 2. Express Bus

- Time: approx. 2.5 hours from Haneda APT to KEK.
- Fare: from 2,300 JPY/16 USD to 5,500 JPY/40 USD including highway fee.
- Payment: Cash, Credit card, IC Card (PASMO, etc.)







3. In about 20 minutes,


