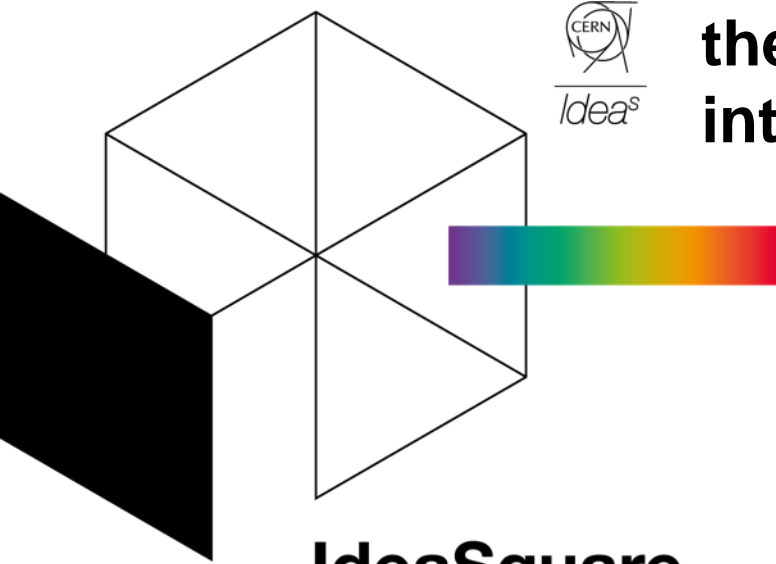


Status of implementation of the 2023 ISAB-G recommendations; Starting the Strategy Planning process; Ad-interim organization

STATUS OF KEY ISAB-G 2023 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1) Update current Strategy Plan (2021-2025) to extend up to 2030: **has started (see memo)**
- 2) Continue the current sharing of administrative tasks between the basic IdeaSquare operations and the EU-funded project activities: **Ad-Interim organization in place (see below)**
- 3) CERN management sets up modest stable long-term baseline funding that covers basic operations that cannot be funded from grants such as by the EU, and some free-running creative activities in addition to the grant-sponsored activities (e.g. ATTRACT): **not yet in place**
- 4) IdeaSquare works together with the CERN management to explore ways to expand the building and suggests that IdeaSquare finds a significant part of the required funding for this expansion from external parties: **formal request submitted, external funding (partially) obtained**
- 5) ISAB-G notes the success of the “Terra Forming” theme for CBIs. It recommends continuing with this theme and to further developing it: **Well in progress (WS's in June and November)**
- 6) CIJ to increase published articles (> 20/year)... and to organise training, especially for young researchers: efforts underway (**e.g. L. Valtonen**)

STATUS OF KEY ISAB-G 2023 RECOMMENDATIONS (2)

- 6) Continuing the effort to work with the EU on ATTRACT-like activities, such as Green Village, CARAT and Women in Tech, and even to intensify the collaboration with the EU on this if possible: **Well in progress (4 submission planned by early 2024)**
- 7) IdeaSquare continues to offer fast prototyping to CERN personnel, continues to host an internal open day (“Open Doors”) and continues to host high-level events to bring together experts from several different domains (e.g. NEB): **Implemented (NEB, FPGA, Arduino, 3D printers...)**
- 8) IdeaSquare explores the possibility to better involve the CERN Member States, especially those from the East and South parts of Europe, e.g., by better promoting IdeaSquare in these countries: **In progress**
- 9) Exploring the possibilities for a residence programme for deep tech innovation. The CERN programmes for fellowships and associateships could provide such a framework. A link could be established with the ECFA detector R&D and training programmes: **In progress**

STRATEGY PLAN 2023 – 2025 UPDATE

- 1) Key activity drivers: ATTRACT (incl. CBI), ramping up Green Village, continuing CERN-offerings (hosting R&D&I initiatives; tech courses/WSs and support to CERN people; Science Gateway offerings; SPARKS)
- 2) Key goals: Further increase/improve relevance for CERN; new Student Program in place by 2025 (“i2P”); building extension by 2025-2026
- 3) Key resources: ATTRACT, budget from CERN assured for 2023, additional income needed by 2024 (see below)
- 4) Key challenges in 2024: Completion of ATTRACT Phase-2 Projects; ramping up ATTRACT P-1B; ramping up i2p-Pilot modules, ramping up Green Village projects (expecting EU-funding)

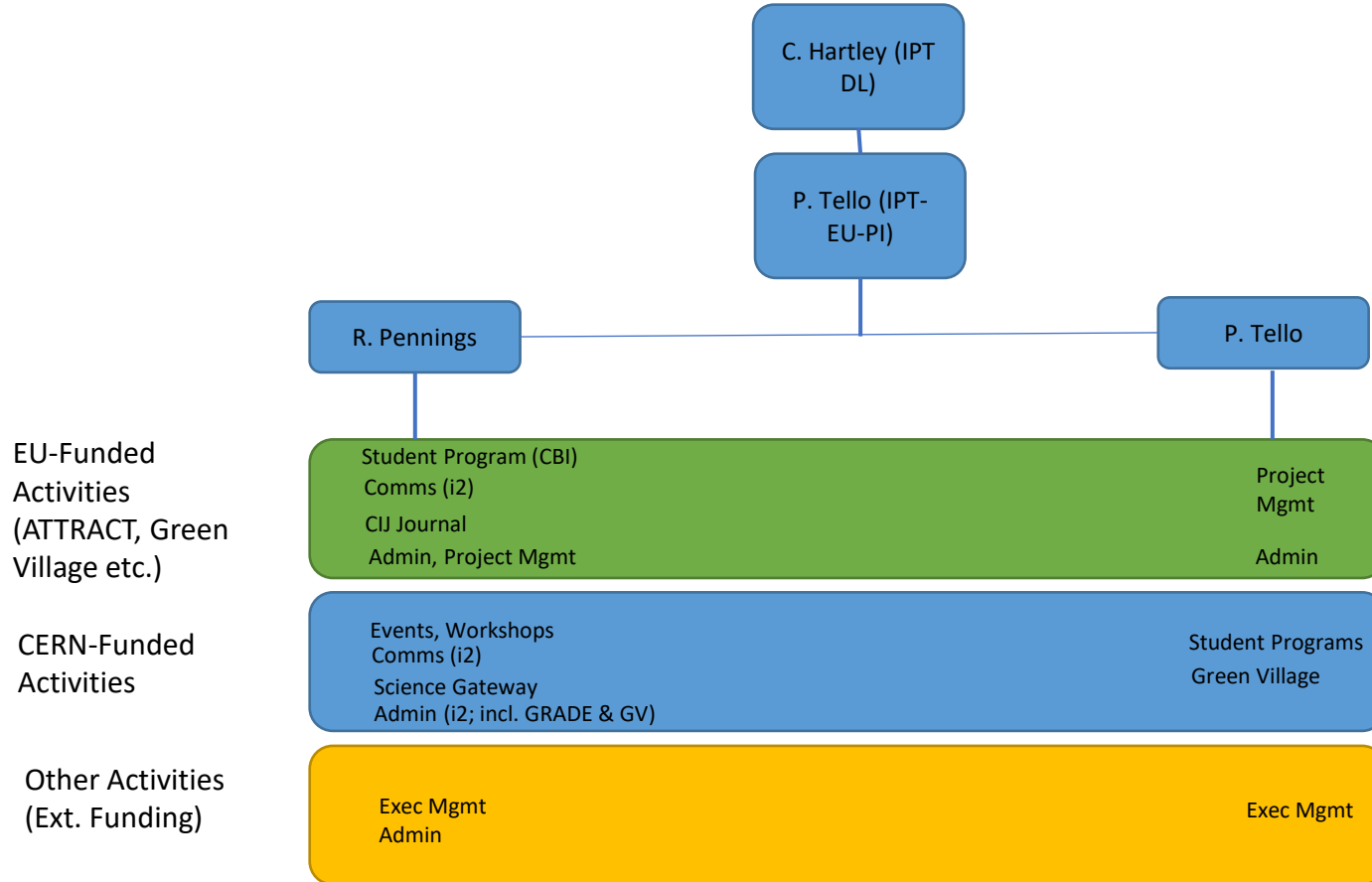

CONCLUSIONS

- i2 activities in 2023 have progressed well along the Strategy Plan
- Over 2100 students have been trained so far by i2 personnel
- Primary focus is in 2024 in ATTRACT Phase 2, 1B and Green Village initiatives. 2024+ CERN budgets need still to be secured
- Increasing activities at i2 necessitate to extend the current building by ca 400m² by 2025-26. Formal request has been submitted
