Status

- The sphinx approach to creating documentation seems very stable/mature now
 - As always thanks to everyone!
 - Slides almost the same as last update and the year before that...
- We had one update this year in August
 - Some included changes were needed (referencing to web-pages and changes to advanced examples)
 - Took the opportunity to try to fix all links and some formatting issues, particularly in the PRM
 - Would welcome anybody to check/notify issues if they are still present.
- e-reader output formats
 - Still present, however unchecked with releases would be good if somebody could do that?
 - Some errors appeared with newer version of sphinx, but I think they were fixed.

Comments

- Can developers please re-base before making a merge request?
 - Not critical, but makes handling merge requests fas
 - I know the pipeline doesn't always work for user pushes I will try to fix this at some point
- As we move to a release phase I would encourage everybody to look at the documentation and consider updates required for new features being introduced in 11.2
- Maybe we can avoid the rush in the last days before the release this year???
 - I ask every time...
- Deadline is Friday 1st December 2023 for release 11.2
 - If something is coming, would be helpful to let me know in advance and I'm happy to help with conversion/formatting etc....
 - As always will accommodate exceptions, but knowing beforehand would be helpful!

External Versions/Translation

- We recently had another request for external permission to translate documents
 - We have copyright posting, and we have twice simply said yes (with caveat of non-support and stating that these are un-official documents with reference back to the official ones in english)
 - Often the translation is for teaching/tutorials
 - It's never clear what happens after the requests
