1. From SB actions:

We limited to pub-board & publications questions

- **129.2 on Marc "To discuss at the pub board level the possibility to have a system (eg JIRA) to track the discussion on new publications**
 - Reminded that the pub board should track & review conference presentations, related abstracts, proceedings, and papers for journals
 - Don't need to review workshops material
 - It is mentioned that finding reviewer is not easy
 - Often the same persons in practice
 - Koichi presented a nice JIRA implementation to respond to the need for tracking progress in the reviews and to ensure the desired privacy during the review process
 - Need to verify this indeed responds well to the needs
 - Will make easy to get the list of papers & conferences
- **114.2 on Koichi "Create Indico entries for every past publication. Contact past Publication Board chairs to identify past publications. Also consider using JIRA for tracking new publications"**
 - Obsolete (with previous and next items)
- **100.2 on Makoto "to ensure about visibility of publication (94.4 follow-up)"**
 - We lost the update of papers from quite time
 - A call will be made to recover the missing publications
 - Proposed that theses which have contributed to Geant4 are also visible
 - A page will be (re)created (somewhat lost in the Drupal → Jekyll)
- **General comments / questions:**
 - Is publication policy visible from pub board page ?
 - Yes
 - Members will be invited to respect the review time
 - Members will be invited them to alert well before the review, so that reviewers can be found, etc. even if the text comes late

2. Internal Indico:

- **Creation of an internal Indico was proposed for:**
 - For Collaboration internal SB minutes
 - Internal seminars
 - WG meeting announcements
 - Storage of internal notes ?
 - etc.
- **But...**
 - *We have already an internal Indico !*
 - Used by WGs and some various things
- **Proposal:**
 - Review & refresh & augment this Indico
 - With above items
 - Creation a new Jekyll website page
 - with the link on the root of this Indico
 - Instructions about how to handle calendars
 - Subscribe to events
 - etc.

3. Web site

- **Are there pages we'd wish to have ?**
 - list of publications
 - list of thesis
 - page on internal Indico
 - JIRA linked to pub board page
 - list of technical notes
 - public page of “lack of resources requirements”
 - to motivate new contributions
 - could be simply through JIRA filter
 - web site of local groups
- **Tool(s) to help the census ?**
 - Instead of Google-based tools (not allowed everywhere : eg Korea)
 - Proposed to assess/use Limesurvey
- **Creation of a mini-page / member ?**
 - With key info:
 - name,
 - e-mail,
 - FTE in various WG
 - ...
