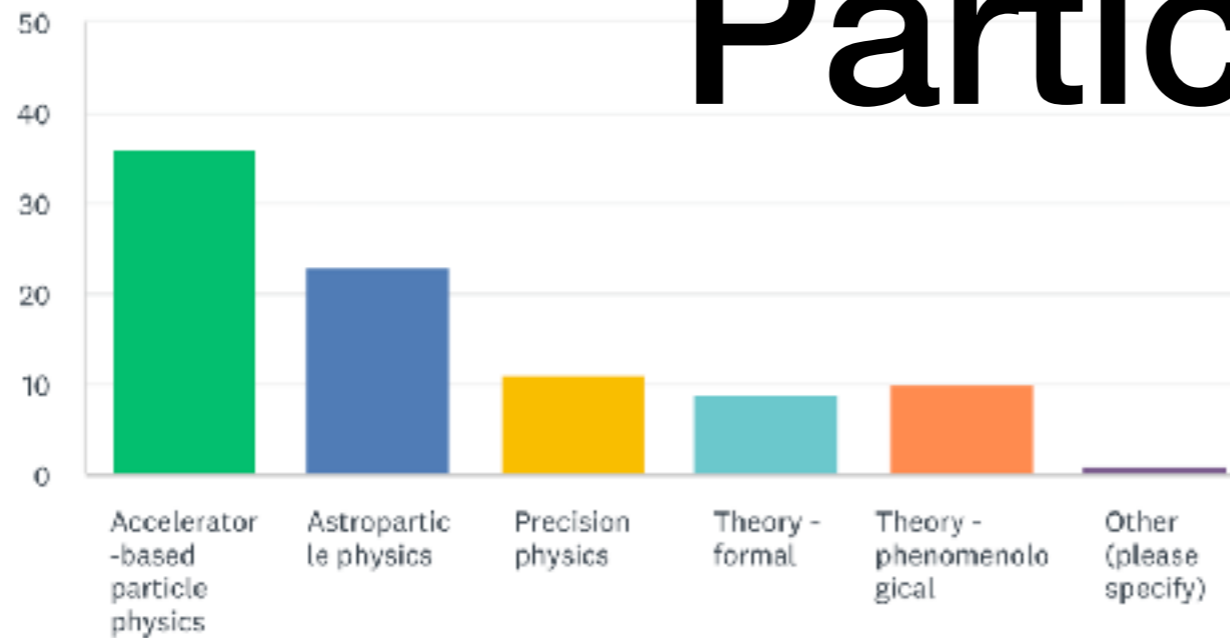

# Town Hall and IPP Grant

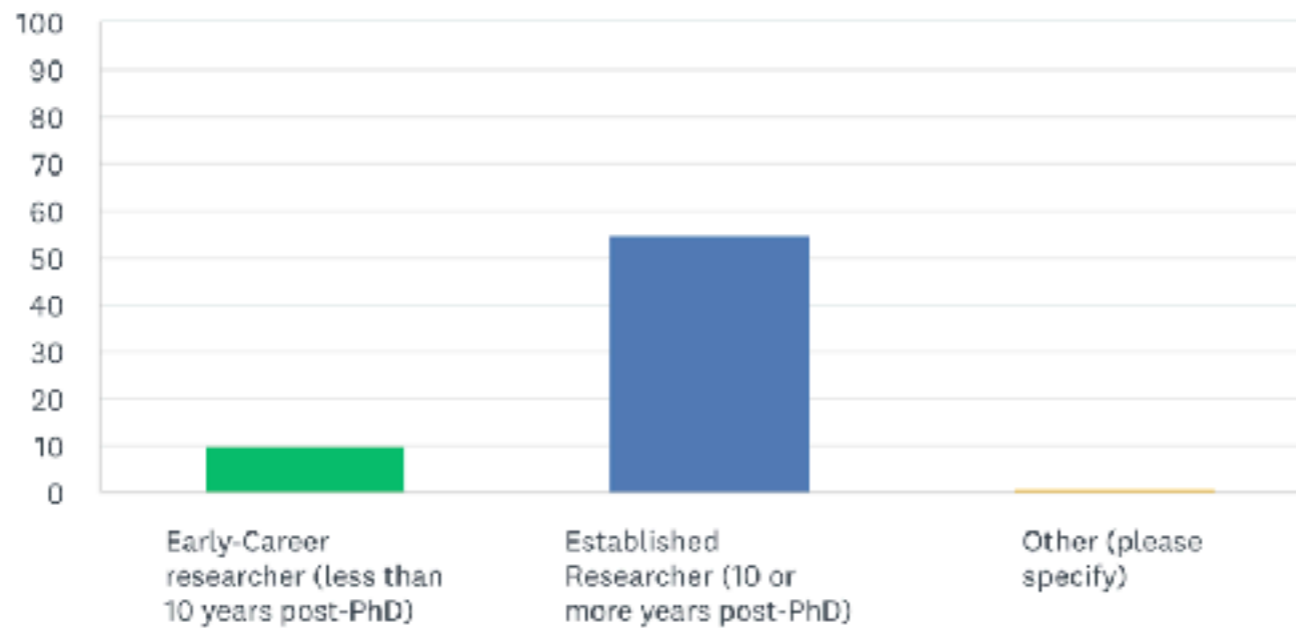
- We are in year 6 of the 5 year grant

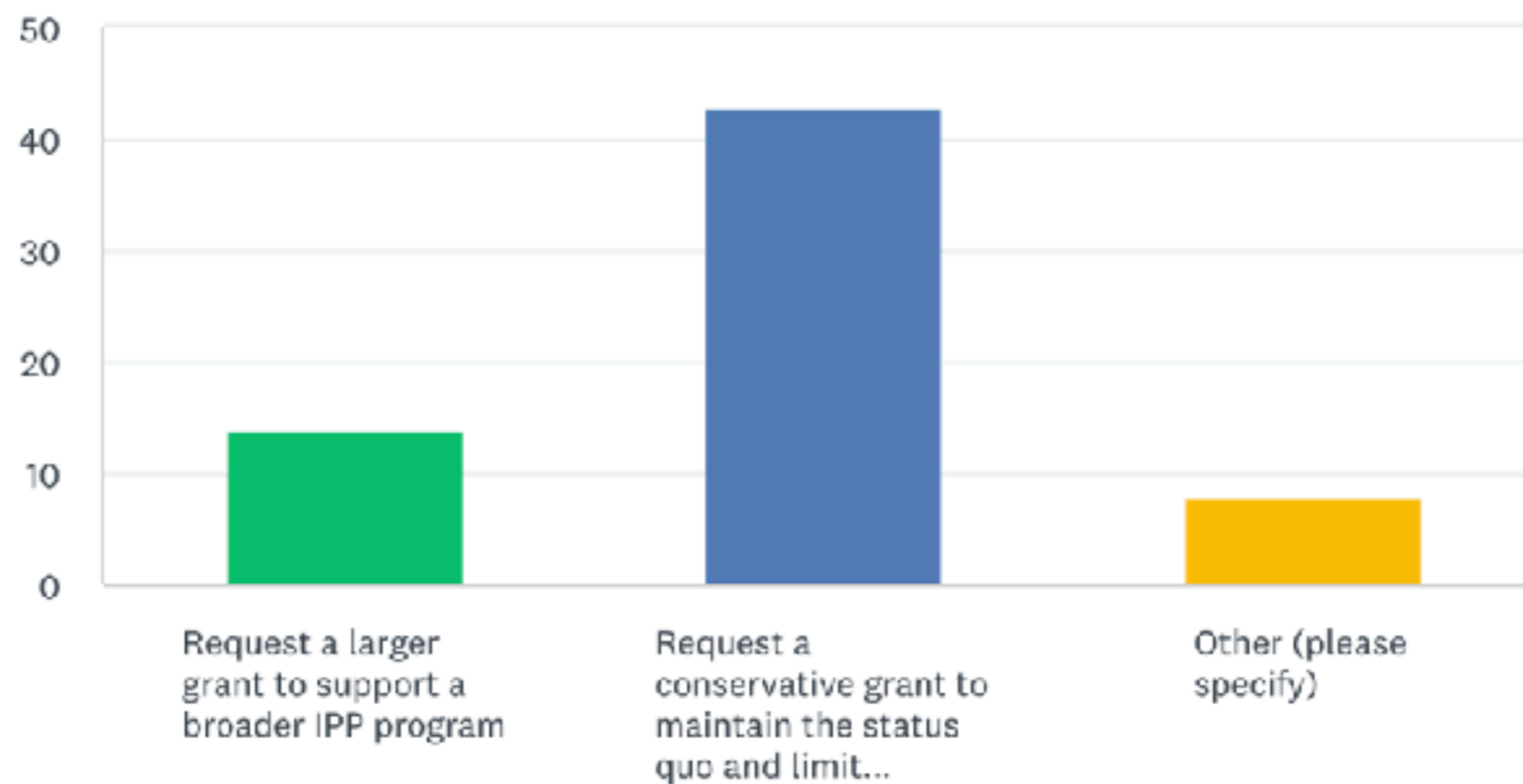

Given that the IPP MRS grant is funded within the NSERC subatomic physics envelope, choose your high-level preference for the scope of the next grant request.

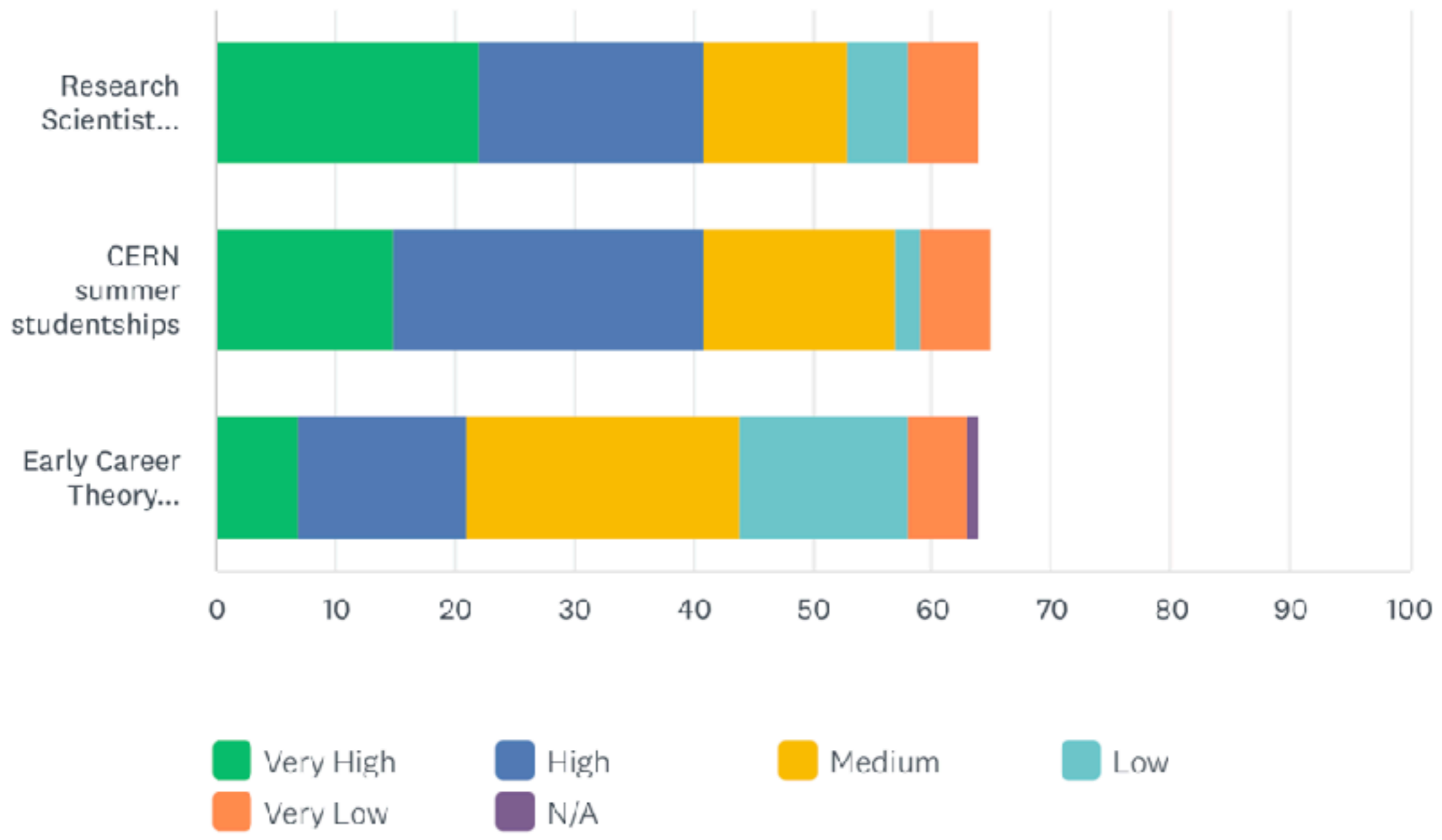

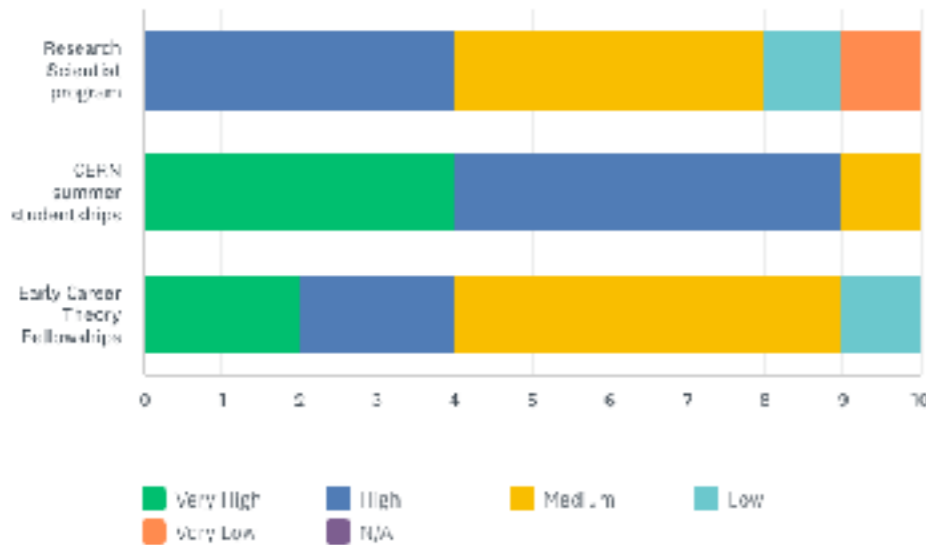

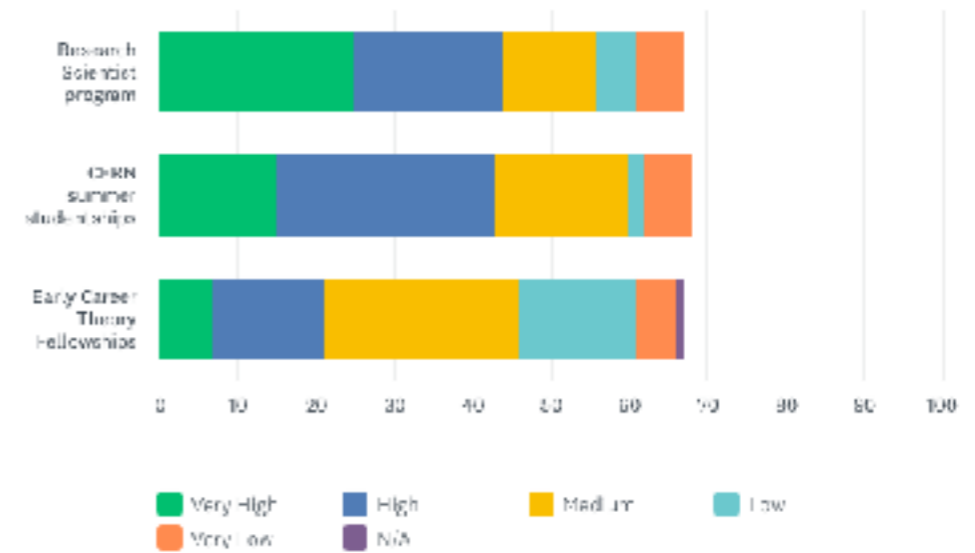
