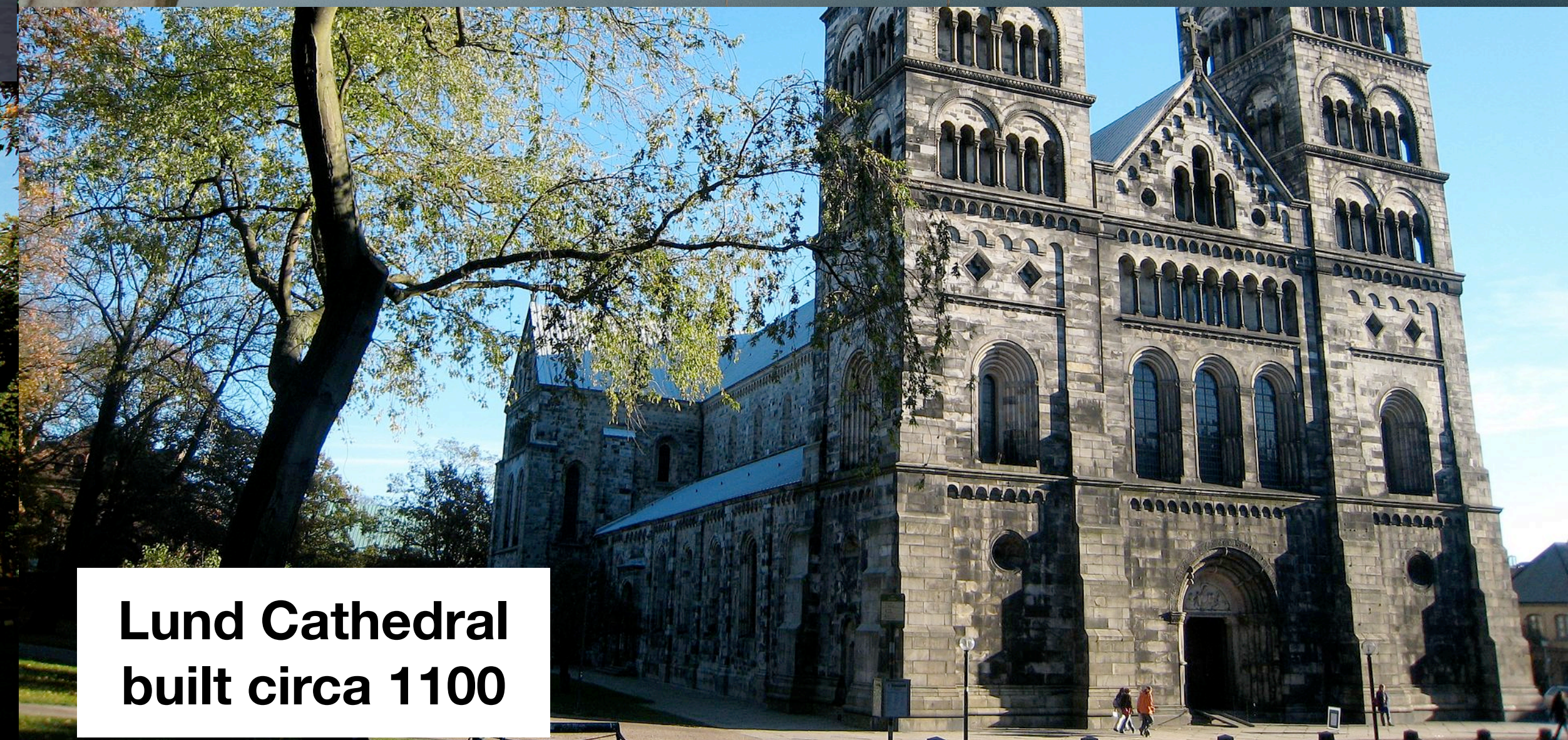

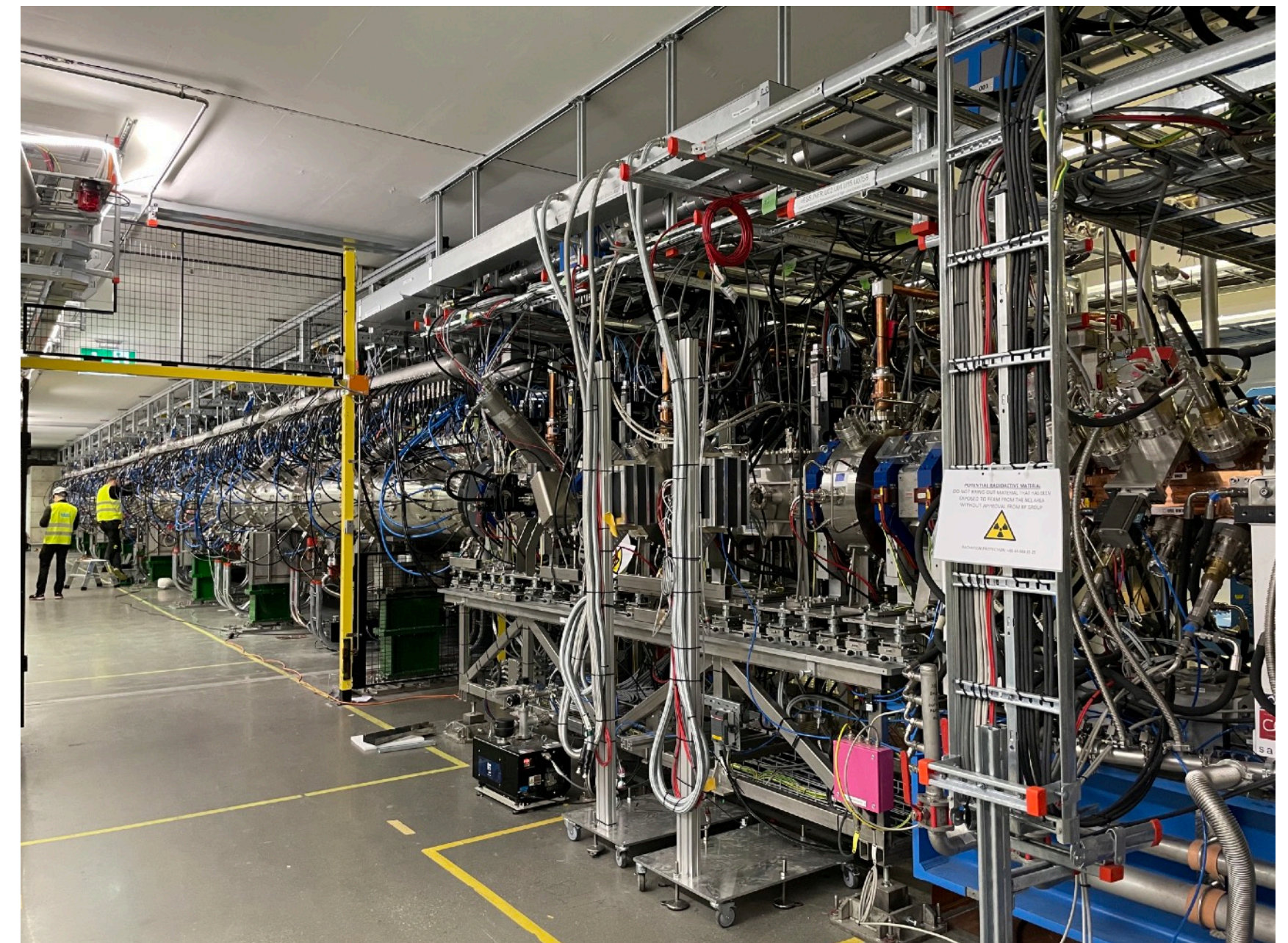
Ask questions!
