There will be 3 talks each morning, and 2-3 additional talks in the afternoon, each followed by some discussion time. We will have coffee breaks just before the morning and afternoon sessions. Additional time is allocated for informal discussions after lunch.

- There will be a return bus from Benasque to Barcelona on Saturday Oct 7 at 9am, arriving in Barcelona around 1-2pm.

- There is no lunch/dinner service at the science center but there are many restaurants nearby offering good food (and wine) for a reasonable price.
