

# What is FIM4R?

**FIM4R** (Federated Identity Management for Research) is a **collection** of research communities and infrastructures with a **shared interest** in **enabling** Federated Identity Management for their research cyber infrastructures.

In order to achieve this, FIM4R develops **requirements** bearing on technical architecture, federated identity management, and operational policies needed to achieve a harmonious integration between research cyber infrastructures and R&E Federations.

These requirements may apply to R&E Federations, the research cyber infrastructures, or proxies and other components that link them together.

FIM4R members collaborate with organisations in both domains, R&E

Federation and research cyber infrastructures, to help implement these requirements.

An initial white paper was produced in 2012 to document common requirements, a common vision and recommendations




### FIM4R Paper 2018

A second white paper was published in 2018 to highlight the progress since 2012 and the prevailing challenges.


