To the Memorandum on Cooperation (MoC)
for the International Muon Collider Collaboration (IMCC) Study

This Addendum defines a contribution by INSTITUTE (referred to as INSTITUTE Acronym) under Article 5 of the Memorandum on Cooperation (MoC) for the International Muon Collider Collaboration (IMCC) Study signed by INSTITUTE as a Participant in the IMCC Study

1. As part of its contribution to the IMCC Study, **INSTITUTE** shall perform the following activities:

2. In accordance with Article 4.3 of the MoC for the IMCC Study, it is agreed that for periods of between one (1) to thirty six (36) months at CERN, the **INSTITUTE** experts may be appointed as Associated Members of CERN Personnel (with Cooperation Associate status) pursuant to CERN's Staff Rules and Regulations, from which it follows that, for the entire duration of their association with CERN:

(i) **INSTITUTE** experts shall be employed by or enrolled as students at **INSTITUTE**;

(ii) **INSTITUTE** shall be responsible for their social insurance, which shall include cover for occupational illness and accidents;

(iii) the **INSTITUTE** experts shall maintain medical insurance cover adequate in Switzerland and France for themselves and accompanying family members;

(iv) such medical insurance shall also cover for any duty travel required as part of the Project; and

(v) the **INSTITUTE** experts shall have adequate financial resources to support themselves and accompanying family members.

3. This addendum shall be valid for the period 2024-2027.
