At the University of Oslo, we are developing and integrating solutions for data capture, storage, analysis and dissemination, to make it a little easier for researchers to work safely with sensitive data. The collection of services are what make up our internally developed research platform, called Educloud research. The goal is to make the platform with all the solutions it contains user friendly and self service based, while still maintaining high levels of security. The platform itself provides flexibility and allows for collaboration, both with colleagues working at the university, but also with external collaborators situated across the globe.
