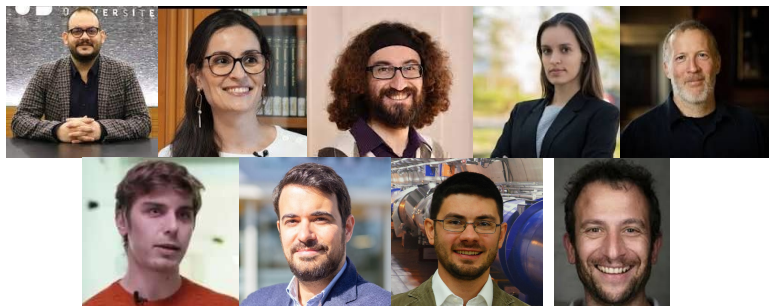

- **Massive thanks** to the local organisers for mustering so many listeners !

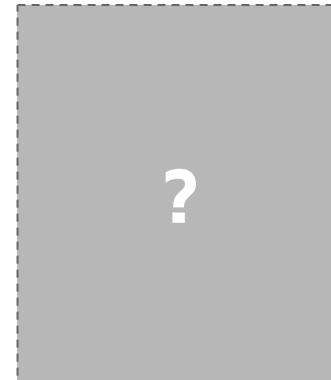
- Development of the General Meeting → We have 2/3 of the colloquia organising team !

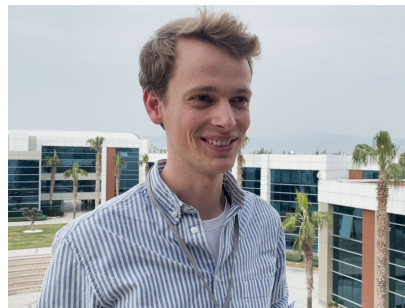
