- If you present a **plenary or parallel talk**, please check when your talk is scheduled and make sure that you **upload your presentation on indico until the evening the day before your talk**.
- If you present a **poster**, please make sure that **you upload it on indico during the week before the poster session, i.e., until April 4, 2025 latest. Contributions not uploaded until then will not be considered for the Flash Talk Award!**

#### **Check-in:**

- I. The check-in for **early-career researchers** will take place on the Early-Career Researcher Day, April 6, 2025.
- II. The check-in for **all other participants** will take place at the Campus Westend starting 8:00 on Monday, April 7, 2025:
  - On Monday, April 7, 2025, we will have an **express check-in from 8:00 - 13:00 on the ground floor of the Lecture Hall Center at the Campus Westend**, where the conference will take place.
  - The check-in desk will move to the **Conference Office on the 3rd floor of the Lecture Hall Center after 13:00** on Monday, April 7, 2025.

At check-in, registered participants will receive their conference materials, including a confirmation-of-participation statement. This statement will also quote the **total registration fee paid**, i.e., including lunches and conference dinner, but excluding excursions, etc.
