Welcome to Oxford


The university has a long and convoluted history

• Founding of the university in c1096

 Large expansion following Henry II ban on student attendance at the University of Paris in 1167

The university structure reflects its organic growth

- 39 constituent colleges, operating independently
- 4 divisions, sub-divided into departments

- Meet at **15:00** on Friday outside the DWB to walk to the Cherwell Boat House


