→ A specific author list will have to be created

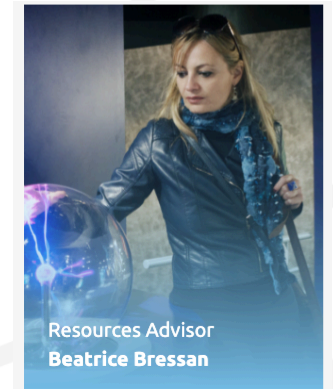

1st on 2024 priority list : IPPOG notes

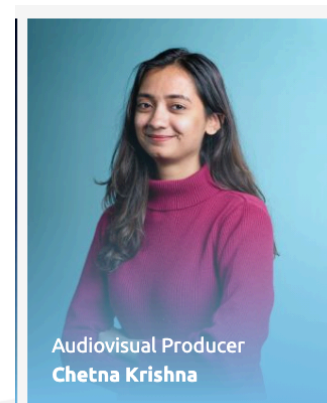
- A new student will arrive on May the 1st and work on this for 4 months

 - ✓ Evaluation/update of the Scientific Secretary position setup (together with new chairs)





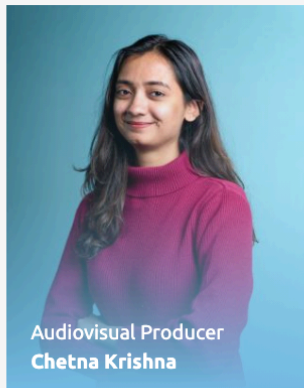
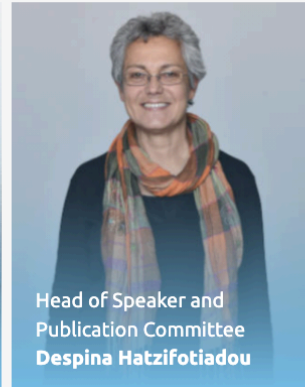
