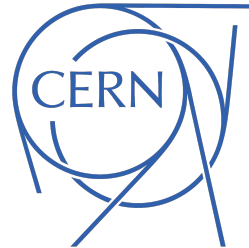
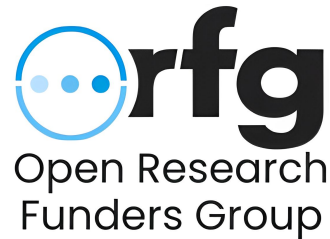


Accelerating the adoption of open science





- 26 members
 - \$250 billion in combined assets
 - \$12 billion in combined annual grants
- Two core workstreams
 - Funder community of practice
 - Funders' voice in cross-sector discussions

About the Summit



- 10 to 14 July 2023 - Geneva, Switzerland
- Organized jointly by CERN & NASA
- 104 participants at CERN and 199 online
- Exchanges were exclusively policy-oriented, focus on strategic plans



Closing statement

- Published Nov. 1st
- Written in collaboration with summit participants
- English + community-driven translations: French, Spanish, German, Arabic, Chinese



Call to action



1. **Post-summit:** Survey (50% participation)
2. **October:** survey analysis and WG definition
3. **Mid-Nov:** First community calls (15–20 participants avg.)
4. **Dec:** definition of deliverables and success per WG

What's the value?

- **Regional & international alignment**
 - US + Europe, Japan, China, Latin America, Africa
 - Avoid overlapping, advance faster
- Advocacy: access to IRL **institutional testing arenas**
- More focus on areas like **FOSS/FOSH**
