American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Science & Technology Policy Fellowships

AAAS Science & Technology Policy Fellowships (STPF) provide opportunities to outstanding scientists and engineers to learn first-hand about policymaking and contribute their knowledge and analytical skills in the policy realm through yearlong assignments in the federal government. AAAS STPF is open to U.S. citizens who hold a doctorate level science degree or a master's in engineering and are at any stage in their career.

The DOE is an agency partner of the AAAS STPF. Interested applicants apply to AAAS, candidates selected as semi-finalists have the opportunity to interview for placement within the DOE Office of Science. Appointments are for one year with the option to renew for a second year.
