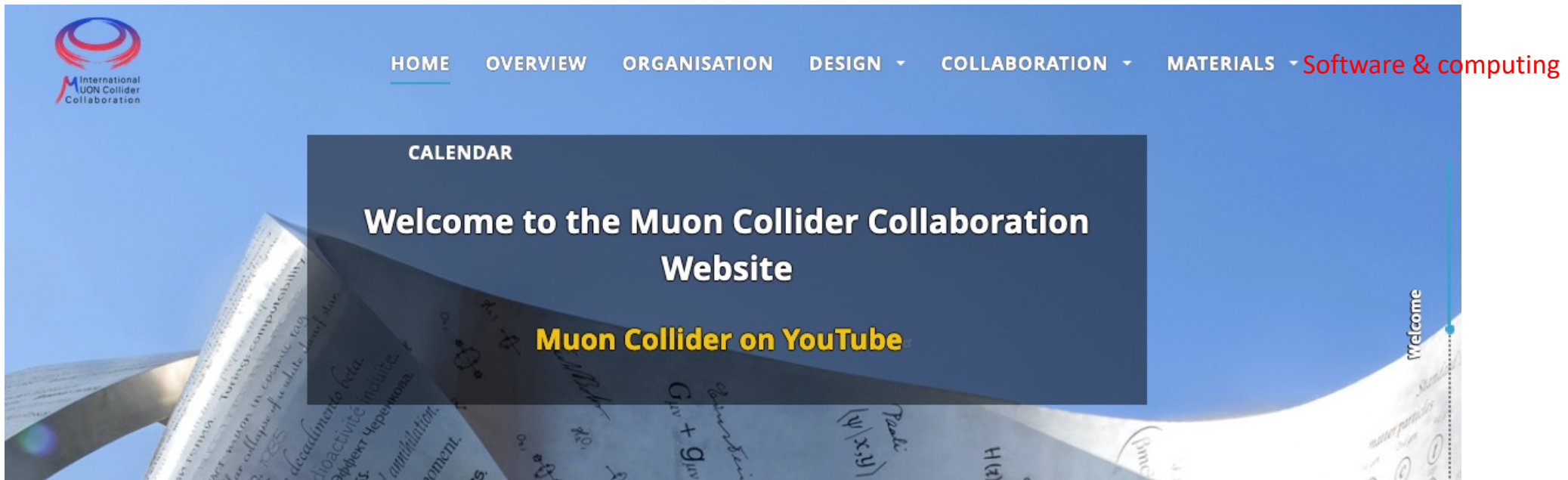


# Software support
