The 3rd edition of the Triggering Discoveries in High Energy Physics workshop will take place in High Tatras, Slovakia, between December 9th and December 13th of 2024. The purpose of this workshop is to discuss the role of triggering in enabling studies in high energy physics and astroparticle physics experiments, and in discussing the latest developments in the technical execution of triggers. The conference also covers both theory and experiment/observations in high energy physics in most actual and critical points.

Venue

The workshop will be held at the congress facilities of the Atrium Hotel which is located in Nový Smokovec, in High Tatras, Slovakia. The hotel hosted a successful CERN Accelerator School in September 2019.

Transport

The venue is in close vicinity of three international airports: Poprad-Tatry airport (13 km), Košice airport (116 km) and Krakow airport (160 km). If requested, the organisers can organize for you a transport from any of the three airports to the hotel and back. Other international airports are in Vienna, Budapest, Prague and Bratislava. The nearest town, Poprad, is well connected by train, bus and road links.
