## **Forewords**


#### **Everything in these slides is up for discussion**

## Role of conveners

- Make sure information is flowing in the collaboration
  - i.e all groups are aware of what others are doing, and share the work when appropriate
- Participation in corresponding working groups in DRD6
  - How exactly? Will depend on how these working groups are organized
- Speakers Committee
  - Be aware of conferences, encourage people to submit abstracts, ask for people interested to give talks...
  - Coordinate at DRD6 level in case of "DRD6" talks in conferences

## Meetings

  - Can create sub-categories as needed
- Fixed monthly general meeting, with dates known in advance
