

Dining Suggestions in the Notre Dame Area

On campus options:

1. *Au Bon Pain* – located in Hesburgh Library. Counter-service chain cafe serving soups, salads & sandwiches along with breads & other baked goods.
2. *Garbanzo Mediterranean Fresh* – located in the Hesburgh Center for International Studies. Offers scratch-made, preservative-free menu options including pitas, gyros, salads, flatbreads and more.
3. *LaFortune Student Center* (the “Huddle”) – located just north of Hayes-Healy. Inside are Flip Kitchen, Huddle Mart, Smashburger, Starbucks and The Noodle Nook.
4. *Legends* – located just south of the stadium. Vegetarian options. ND’s own restaurant/pub.
5. *Rohr’s Tavern* – located in the Morris Inn on campus. A casual, warm gathering place with a focus on bright, flavorful food. Imagine a classic steakhouse with a twist highlighting colorful vegetables, fresh fish, and of course, signature steaks. Also has a full bar.
6. *Duncan Student Center* – located on the west side of the football stadium. Hagerty Family Café, Modern Market, and Chick-fil-A.

Walking distance from campus:

1. *Eddy Street Commons* – just south of campus. Blaze Pizza, Brothers Bar & Grill, Bru Burger Bar, Chipotle, Dave’s Hot Chicken, Five Guys, Jimmy John’s and more!

Other options in South Bend/Mishawaka:

1. *Barnaby’s* – 3724 Grape Road, Mishawaka and 713 E. Jefferson, South Bend. Vegetarian options. Pizza, sandwiches, and a bar.
2. *Bruno’s Pizza* – 119 Dixie Way North, South Bend. Vegetarian options. Popular local pizzeria.
3. *Cambodian Thai Restaurant* – 235 S. Michigan St., South Bend. Very good traditional Thai food.
4. *Chicory Cafe* - 105 E Jefferson Ste. 103, South Bend. Laid back and casual with seriously good food that has a New Orleans flair, coffee bar, and alcohol.
5. *Cre-Asian Vietnamese Restaurant* – 1639 N. Ironwood, South Bend. Fresh Asian dishes, many choices.
6. *Crooked Ewe Brewery & Ale House* – 1047 Lincolnway E, South Bend. Gastro brewery located along the St. Joseph River.
Evil Czech Brewery and Public House – 3703 N Main St., Mishawaka. Hand-crafted brews and great food.
7. *Fatbird Eatery* - 103 W Colfax, South Bend. Good sandwiches. Has full bar.
8. *Fiddler’s Hearth* – 127 N. Main St., South Bend. Vegetarian options. An Irish public house with an extensive selection of beer on tap and live music most nights. The food is good and the kitchen is open ‘til 11pm. This place is small and gets packed by about 9pm.
9. *The General Deli and Cafe* – 609 E Jefferson Blvd., South Bend. Located next door to The Hammer & Quill. Serves primarily sandwiches, soups, and salads. Breakfast and lunch options for sandwiches.
10. *The Hammer & Quill* – 613 E Jefferson Blvd., South Bend. Located next door to the The General Deli and Cafe. Cocktail bar that serves a wide assortment of cocktails. Open until midnight.
11. *The Lauber* - 504 LaSalle Ave., South Bend. Casual food, inspired cocktails and craft beer.
12. *India Garden* – 615 W. Edison Rd., Mishawaka. Vegetarian, vegan and gluten options.
13. *Ironhand Wine Bar* – 1025 Northside Blvd., South Bend. Located on the Saint Joseph River. Serves some food on small plates with various wine options.
14. *La Esperanza* – 1636 N. Ironwood, South Bend. Traditional Mexican food. Vegetarian and gluten-free options.

15. *Martin's Supermarket* – located farther north on the corner of S.R. 23 and Ironwood. Large deli offering sushi, paninis, soups, large salad bar, and a Starbucks. This is a longer walk to attempt over a lunch hour.
16. *Noodle Alley* – 2370 Miracle Lane, Mishawaka. Vegetarian, vegan, and gluten-free options.
17. *Peggs* – 127 S. Michigan St, South Bend. Old-fashioned American dining for breakfast and lunch in a modern space with outdoor tables.
18. *Seoul Garden* – 1628 East McKinley, Mishawaka. Korean and Japanese food. Enormous menu!
19. *South Bend Brew Werks* – 216 S. Michigan St, South Bend. Only family-owned and operated brew pub with handcrafted brews and great food.
20. *Toyo Grill* – 620 W. Edison #106, Mishawaka. Vegetarian and vegan options. Sushi, tempura, and other Japanese and Korean dishes.
21. *Strip mall on S.R. 23* – J.W. Chens (delicious Chinese food!), Studebagels, Taphouse on the Edge and Waka Dog (Gourmet hot dogs, sandwi19 N Michigan Street, South Bend. Great sushi, martinis, and good selection of Japanese and Asian entrees.

Fine Dining Options \$\$\$:

1. *Café Navarre* – 101 N. Michigan St., South Bend. Modern American cuisine with French, Spanish, and Italian influences. Great fresh seafood selection. Located in a historic building in downtown South Bend.
2. *Carmela's at Macri's* – 214 N. Niles Ave., South Bend. Italian Bistro that serves wonderful homemade food. Right next to Macri's Bakery which has mouthwatering pastries, cookies, and cakes.
3. *Corndance* – 4725 Grape Rd., Mishawaka. Ample plates of familiar, farm-fresh American fare served amid a comfortable country vibe.
4. *LaSalle Grill* – 115 W. Colfax, South Bend. Modern American Bistro that has received the Four Diamond Award for 19 consecutive years. Locally sourced ingredients. Great wine selection.
5. *Render Kitchen & Bar* – 521 E Jefferson Blvd., South Bend. Contemporary cooking in a modern, urban atmosphere.
6. *The Carriage House Dining and Gardens* – Cuisine is High Style International serving also vegetarian and vegan dishes. Received the Four Diamond Reward for 23 consecutive years. Grow their own foods and utilize surrounding farms for the freshest ingredients. Housed in a historic church that was built in 1851. The artwork and gardens are beautiful to take in after a great meal too. Dress code is business casual and up!
7. *Tippecanoe Place* – 620 W. Washington St., South Bend. Located in the former Studebaker Mansion. Good food that is reasonably priced. Casual dress is allowed. Tour the mansion after you are finished eating!
