






FDF 2024: some numbers




- 197 registered participants
 - 137 CERN users, 60 not CERN users
 - 160 from Academia, 37 from industry
- 131 in person participants
 - Plus at least 2 intruders
 - 79 people eating together
- 114 connected to the webcast (peak)
- 69 submitted abstracts, 30 accepted
 - 9 algorithms, 11 tools, 5 HDL cores, 5 solutions
 - 18 hours talking time











The FPGA Developers' Forum






The forum's goal is to create an **open community** of FPGA developers from any background.


We will keep you up to date with our newsletter (register here!).




We are already thinking about FDF2025...
