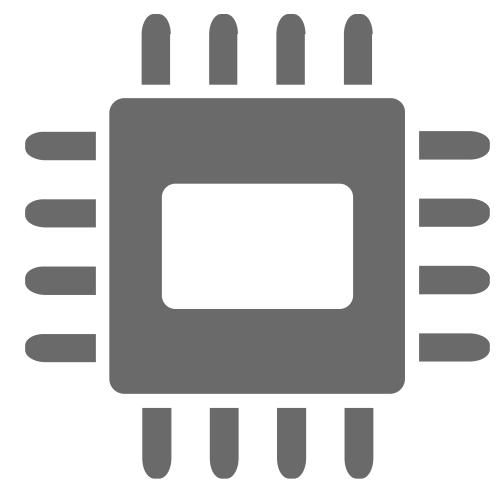


FDF 2024: some numbers



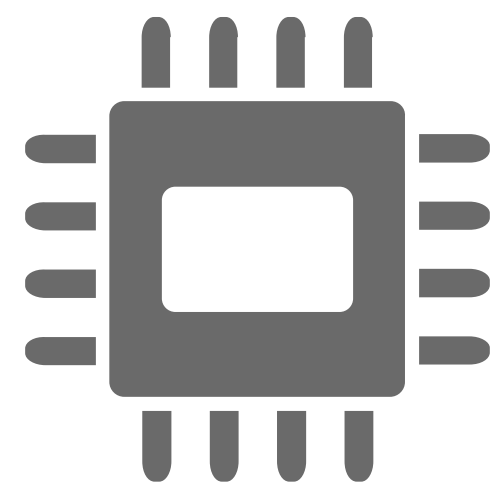
- **197** registered participants
 - **137** CERN users, **60** not CERN users
 - **160** from Academia, **37** from industry
- **131** in person participants
 - Plus **at least 2** intruders
 - **79** people eating together

- **69** submitted abstracts, **30** accepted
 - **9** algorithms, **11** tools, **5** HDL cores, **5** solutions
 - **18 hours** talking time





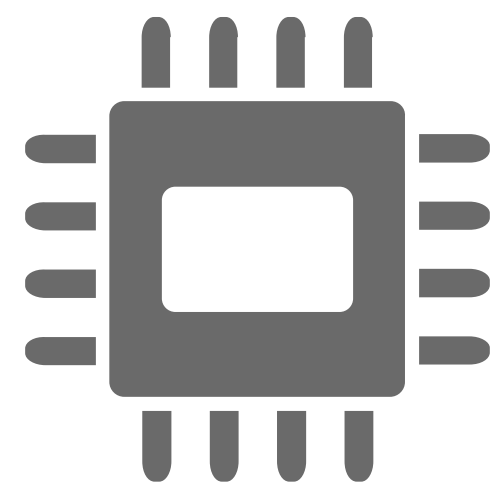

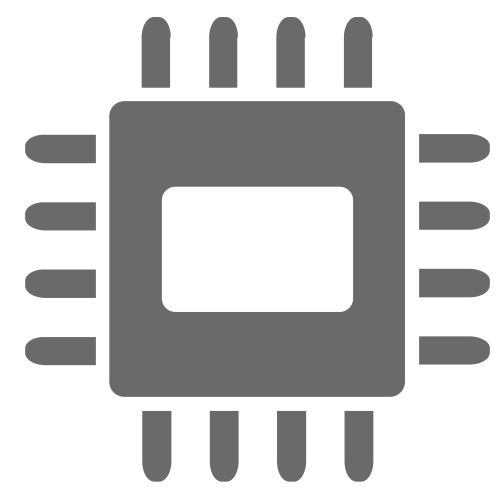




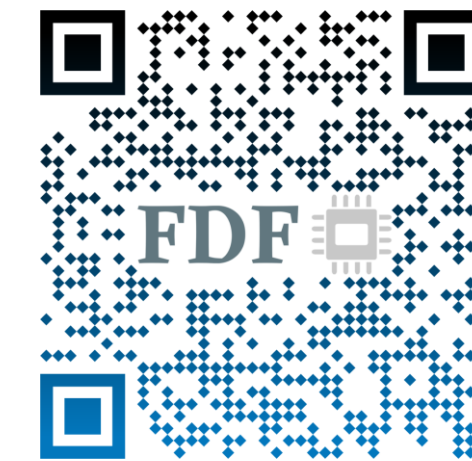
FDF 2024: (my) impressions

- People were **happily chatting** during coffee breaks, hopefully, it won't end there!



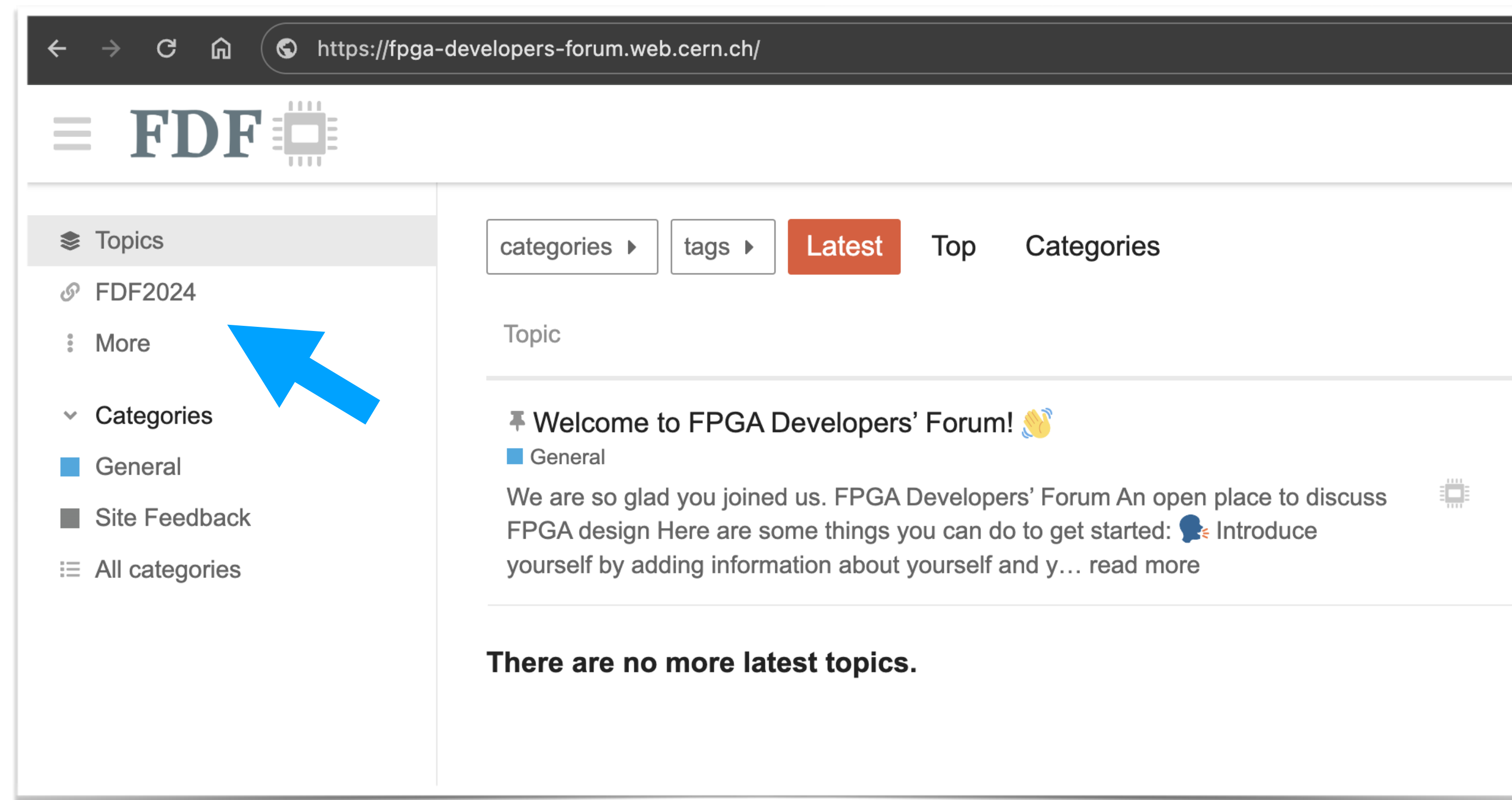
The FPGA Developers' Forum



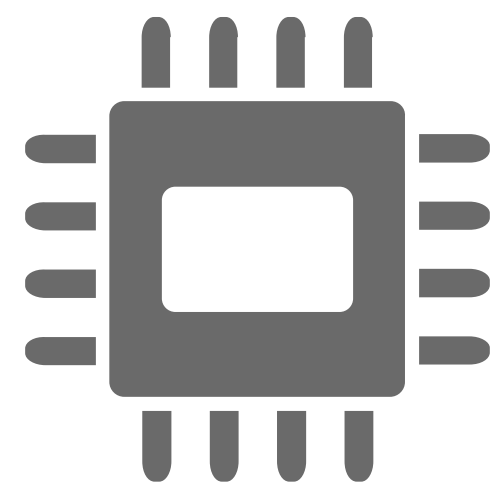
The forum's goal is to create an **open community** of FPGA developers from any background.

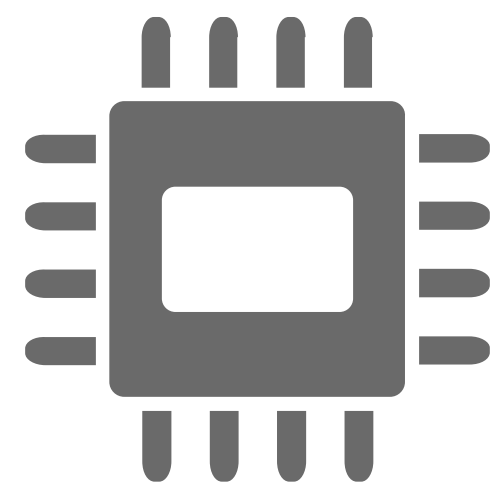

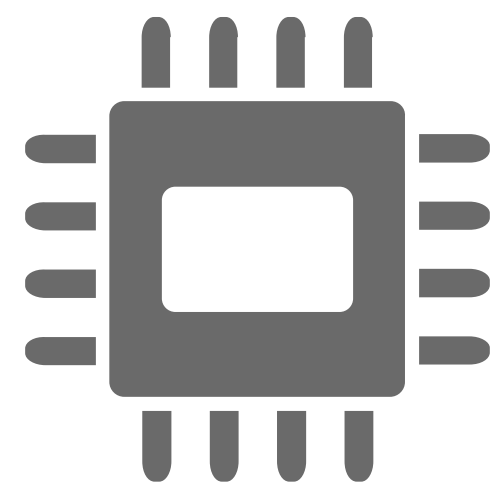
FDF seminars

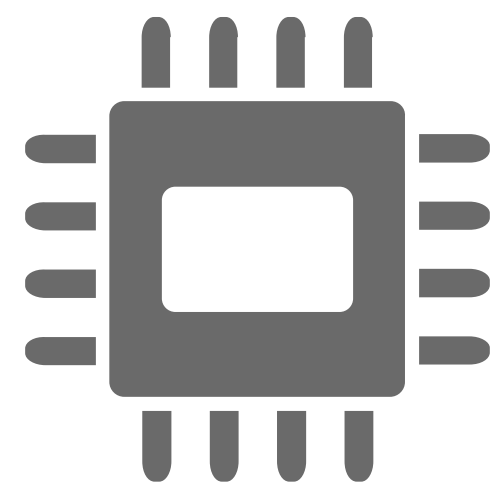

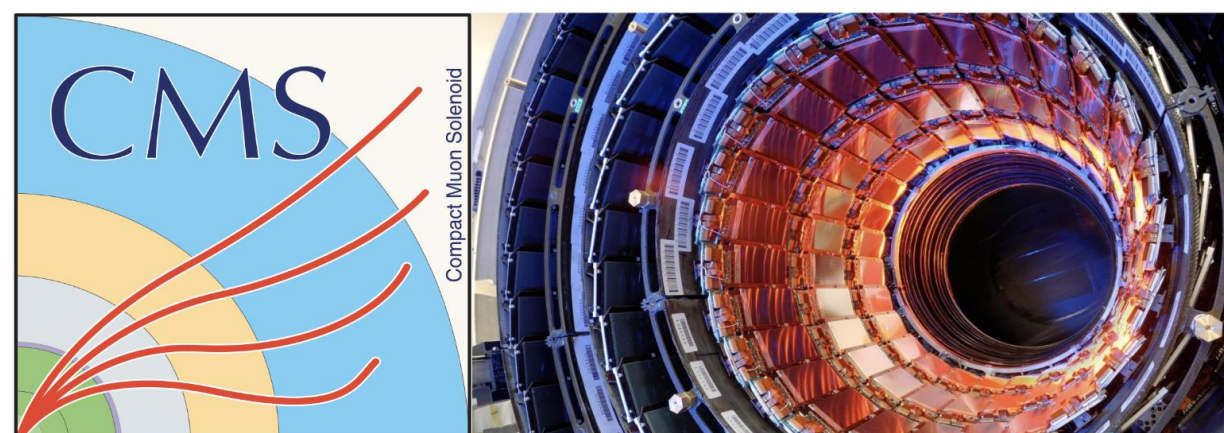
