- Alpha/Test1: December 2010, Beta: in **February 2011**
- We – Linux Support – would like to:
 - Supply SLC6 production release certified at least for generic desktop/server usage in **June 2011**
 - Make SLC6 fully certified before **2011 end**.

What happened
next?

- Feb 14: SLC 6.0 Beta announced
- SLC 6.0 includes CERN-addons:
 - openafs 1.4.14-1.cern in testing
 - phonebook, useraddcern, lpadmincern, ...
 - plus new tool: cern-config-users
 - oracle-instant-client 11.2.0.2.0
 - OCS inventory + quattor component
- AIMS installation targets
 - With a “CERN recommended setup”
 - Also: SLC6 images available in CVI <http://cern.ch/cvi>

- Documentation on <http://cern.ch/linux> updated
- Progress tracked on

- Today: ~170 SLC6 nodes
 - Including LXPLUS6

- RHEL 6.1 released on May 19
- SLC 6.1 packages to be released next week
- Mid-June: SLC 6.1 integrated release
- **Basis for certified release for generic desktop/server usage**
 - To be announced end of summer 2011
