SAC tasks (APPEC MoU)



Article 6: The Scientific Advisory Committee

- The General Assembly shall establish a Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC):
 - (a) to examine and report on issues of strategic scientific importance within their fields of competence;
 - (b) to propose programs or projects for adoption as activities of APPEC; and
 - (c) to organize activities or carry out other tasks entrusted to them by the General Assembly.
- The General Assembly shall appoint the Chairperson, the SAC shall nominate candidates among its members for a mandate of two years, renewable once....
- The Chairperson shall convene the SAC at least once a year and shall report to the General Assembly.
- The operation of Scientific Advisory Committee shall be set under the rules of procedure of APPEC as approved by the General Assembly.
- The members serve 'ad personam'.

SAC discussion regarding chair



Towards the SAC chair (+ co-chair):

- Workload of the chair is estimated (by Sijbrand) as non-uniform distributed with approx. half to one day a week.
- Nominations shall be done by the SAC members and approved by the GA
- Nominations can be done by every SAC member by Email to Katharina (as secretary) and Sijbrand (as former chair) and shall be done until mid of March followed by a discussion with the nominees of possible availability
- Start of the terms of office ideally at the April SAC meeting

Letter of mandate



- Discussion today the view from SAC
- Discussion on Thursday (GA meeting) the view from GA

Based on letter of charge to SAC Feb. 2013

- In particular, the SAC shall:
 - establish and update the roadmap of European Astroparticle Physics that examines the medium- and long-term plan of the infrastructures necessary for the advancement of the field;
 - identify the major milestones and decision turning points with respect to the maturity of technologies and/or expected scientific results:
 - address issues of critical R&D and new developments in the field;
 - discuss site issues and the constraints they impose on projects' timescale;
 - possibly represent APPEC in scientific advisory bodies of other organizations such as CERN, ESO and ESA, EuCAPT
 - take into account global developments and represent the European scientific community opinion in the global coordination process happening in the context of Astroparticle Physics (IUPAP)

SAC discussion regarding "letter of mandate"



Discussion of SAC tasks (letter of mandate):

- The first items of a mandate letter (from the General Assembly to the SAC), as presented in the slides, were discussed.
- It was agreed that the main issue is to start preparing the next APPEC roadmap focusing on scientific issues. The mandate should be lightweight and avoid specifications for internal management tasks and unsolicited advice.
- This letter will also be a topic of discussion at the GA meeting on February, 29th.
