

#### I am mindful

I recognize safety signs and comply with them. I take part in workplace safety.



#### I am responsible

I report incidents and near-misses. I integrate lessons learnt.



#### I am open

I speak up about my concerns.
I share about safety with my colleagues, supervisor and safety officers.

I respect access restrictions.
