PPAP Role (so far)



- Maintain an overview of activities within PP and future opportunities
- Develop and maintain science vision and long-term strategy. Develop PP Roadmap (or rather Landscape of UK Particle Physics)
- Consult and interact with PP community. Ensure its views are canvassed and effectively communicated to STFC.
- Provide advice to Science Board on specific questions, e.g. Infrastructure Fund proposals.
- Liaise with other advisory panels, e.g. PAAP, NPAP.
- Activity is demand driven. Typically meet every 2-3 months. More often when needed.


Current programme and Roadmap-2021

Current Activities and Plans

PPAP

- Engaged with Science Board and STFC to understand role of PPAP under new STFC governance changes (20 Mar PPAP meeting)
- STFC Advisory Panel Chairs Meeting (4-Apr)
- Working to understand PPAN Roadmap process (long range prioritised roadmap). Community input.
- PPAP Community meeting 2024
- Preparations for next update of European Strategy for Particle Physics
 (ESPP)
 - Connection with ECFA-UK activities
- Expect to provide input for upcoming Wave 5 PA Infrastructure Fund proposals? Should it be a more joined up effort with other Advisory Panels?



Update for European Strategy for Particle Physics 2026



- ESPP scientific deliberation to enable Europe's decision-making for the future of PP
 - Initiated in 2006, updates in 2013, and 2020
- Timeline announced
 - Community input submission by 31-Mar-2025
 - Conclude process by June 2026
- PPAP and ECFA-UK organise workshops to promote UK engagement in physics briefing book efforts
 - Online half-day on 1 May
 - In-person workshop in September
- September workshop will cover all major aspects of physics studies covering collider and non-collider physics and accelerator and detector R&D
- This will be followed by a community "drafting day". Will take community input to produce a first draft of UK input to briefing book. Further iterations by Mar'2025. PPAP will organise and oversee this.
- Synergetic with PPAN Roadmap







- Working with SB, STFC, ECFA-UK to to ensure community's input is taken into account
- PPAP-2021 Roadmap update is <u>not</u> expected
- PPAP will start collecting community input on PPAN Roadmap and ESPP to capture "global changes" in the programme and community's aspirations
- Working on proforma/questionnaire
- Timeline: distribute to community by early May, return by mid-June.
- In time for a PPAP community meeting this summer

PPAP Community Meeting 2024





- Last meeting, 6-7 Jul 2023 @ Birmingham, was forward-looking received well.
- This year PPAP would like to focus Community Meeting on
 - PPAN Roadmap process. Community input.
 - UK input for ESPP update
- Engagement with questionnaire is crucial. Questions and suggestions are welcome/encouraged.
- Time and venue: polling late June/early July. Dates to be sent around soon. Venue suggestions super-welcome!

- We have a very broad and exciting PP programme.
- Sustaining it and ensuring excellence and leadership is a challenge
- 2024-25 will be critical for shaping the future of PP in UK
 - PPAN Roadmap prioritised 10 yr plan
 - ESPP update in 2026 (national submissions by Mar'2025)
