






Of Physics High Energy Particle Physics Group


HEPP Group: average member age 42

IoP HEPP 2023 expenditure




Total budget £10,550 – similar to 2022, £1000 above pre-Covid trend:

- £4,600 group events, £3,500 external events (has to be less than internal)
- £1,500 committee meetings, £750 newsletters, £200 prizes (max)

Spent allocation to max ability (IoP have not yet sent the summary):

- full spend on meetings and prizes: ~£7,500 / £8,100 claimed/committed discrepancy in IoP / us meeting classifications, residual claims to resolve.
- full spend on prizes: £200 / £200.
- ~£400 / £1,500 on committee meetings: London conf meant little prep travel, but pre-Liverpool meeting also cheap. Likely underspend in 2024.
- ~£50 / £750 on newsletter postage: made unaffordable by new print/postage charges, now only a few special cases sent paper copies.

We have queried the policy of **no prize money for the group prize** – unclear how this "contribution" differs from the outreach (contribution). Response was to query the outreach award! If group-prize money allowed, will require external sponsorship.



IoP HEPP 2024 budget



IoP funding issues (e.g., open-access impacts on publishing income) suggested a budget cut, but we were given 100% of our request:
