## Dinghy Courses Offered by CNV

The **Club Nautique de Versoix (CNV)** is offering special conditions to the YCC members taking its dinghy courses:

- YCC members can subscribe to the weekly dinghy courses for 510 CHF instead of the regular 630 CHF.
- A dinghy advanced course is organised on Fridays. For this course too, YCC members pay only 510 CHF instead of 630 CHF.
- For the summer dinghy course, YCC members pay only 315 CHF instead of 395 CHF.
- The parents/children course is offered at 320 CHF instead of 370 for 4 sessions and 520 CHF instead of 630 for 8 sessions.
- Finally, the autumn course is offered at 450 CHF instead of 550 CHF.


